

FACILITY AND EQUIPMENT

The BYU Natatorium Pool is equipped with two 1-meter springboards, two 3-meter springboards, as well as a 3 and 5 meter platform with a pool deck platform.

Dryland Equipment with additional room is a 1 minute walk away from the pool. It consists of a small spring floor, trampoline, dryboard and stretching mats. Panel mats will be provided around pool deck for stretching as well.

REGISTRATION

All participants must be "Current" members of USA Diving. All athlete and coach entries must be made online at <u>www.divemeets.com</u> prior to **Thursday May 2nd 9AM at 5:00 pm EST**. No athlete or coach will be permitted access to the pool deck without having completed their DiveMeets registration. Athletes may still register after the deadline up until 3 hours prior to their event with an added late fee of \$100. If a coach misses the online registration deadline, a \$20 late fee will be assessed prior to deck authorization.

The event entry fees for this event are \$50 plus a \$20 insurance fee per athlete per event (total \$70 per event).

DIVE CHANGES

All dive changes, including payment, MUST be done online through DiveMeets. Athletes may log into their DiveMeets account to review and update their dive sheets within the timeline outlined below:

- 1. Changes may be made online at no cost before 6pm the night prior to the first day's events, and before 12pm the day prior to all competition days thereafter.
- 2. After the designated times in point 1, athletes may make changes to their dive sheets online at a cost of \$15 per event up until 3 hours prior to their event start time.
- 3. Dive changes will no longer be accepted three hours prior to the corresponding event.

PARTICIPANT COMPORTMENT

USA Diving promotes good sportsmanship from athletes, coaches and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racist or sexist comments, or other intimidating actions directed at judges, meet personnel, athletes, coaches, spectators, or team representatives are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing or bullying, and acts of cyberbullying by members towards any member is strictly prohibited. Retaliation against any person who reports, is thought to have reported, files a complaint or otherwise participates in an investigation or inquiry is also strictly prohibited. False charges shall also be regarded as a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action or other appropriate sanctions. Persons whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. USA Diving may also make referrals to law enforcement officials.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.

JUDGING

Each region will be attended by one AQUA-Certified USA Diving Judge to serve as a Head Referee of the event.

CHECK-IN TABLE

A check-in table will be set up on the pool deck. All participants must visit this table to check in for deck access prior to their first practice

RESTROOMS

Locker rooms on the pool deck are for athlete use only. Coaches, officials, and other nonathlete participants must utilize the locker rooms to the right inner entrance separated from the athletes

Spectators on the 2nd floor viewing area will use restrooms entering the halls of the Richards Building.

FIRST AID/MEDICAL SERVICES

First aid services and lifeguard responders will be available on deck for all days of practice and competition and located nearest the 1m springboards.

COACH HOSPITALITY

A location just off the pool deck will be for coaches hospitality with drinks, snacks and light meals throughout the two day competition

EVENT MERCHANDISE

Custom, event-branded apparel will be available on-site, provided by USA Diving's merchandise partner, Fine Designs. Get your 2024 USA Diving Regional Championships gear at their stand throughout the event!

TICKETING

\$10 entrance (12yrs and up) for all events per day

\$5 entrance (3-11yrs) for all events per day

Ticketing table will be at only entrance thru 2nd floor hall of Richards Building and access to pool spectator seating. Only athletes and coaches entrance through locker rooms on first floor.

FOOD/CONCESSIONS

Pre-packaged food and drink items will be available at the concession area on the second floor nearest to the spectator seating
