Entry Deadline: April 28, 2025. This is a REAL deadline. Entries must be received, in hand, by this date. Postmark dates do not count! Enter online at www.phoenixtabletennisclub.org. Entries without payment will not be accepted. Refunds, less registration fee, will be given to any cancellation requested before April 30, 2025.

Equipment: 7 Butterfly Centerfolds and 7 Butterfly Octet tables with Butterfly nets and posts. Hardwood floor.

Nittaku 3* Premium 40+ white balls sponsored by Paddle Palace.

Rules: All USATT rules and dress code apply. **Please do NOT wear white shirts or any white garment!** Only USATT/ITTF approved equipment allowed.

Eligibility: Players must have current USATT memberships. An USATT membership can be purchased or renewed with your entries. An unrated player may enter and advance in ratings based Singles events (e.g., U-1250, U-1500, etc.) if he/she has a USATT League Rating that is based on 8 or more league matches. Without a league rating, unrated players can enter ratings based events, but cannot advance past the round robin portion. An unrated player is not eligible to enter rated Doubles events.

Ratings eligibility: based on USATT ratings list published on April 24, 2025.

Tournament Format and Policies:

- 1. All Round Robin matches are best 3 of 5 games to 11 points.
- 2. For round robin groups of 4 players or more, 2 players advance to single elimination unless otherwise stated on the entry form.
- 3. All single elimination matches are best 3 of 5 games. Single elimination matches for Open Singles from Quarter Final and beyond are best 4 of 7.
- 4. Must be rated U-2000 to enter U-3600 Doubles.
- 5. Players may not enter more than one event with start times within 15 minutes of each other.
- 6. As per USATT rules, junior ages are as of first day of the tournament; senior ages as of Dec. 31.
- 7. No prizes will be awarded for splits, dumps, default losses or no-shows.
- 8. Players are responsible for being available to play their matches on time. A player may be defaulted if he/she does not show up for his/her match within 10 minutes when his match is called.
- 9. Tournament committee reserves the right to modify or cancel events if there are insufficient entries.



PERSONS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY MUST BE FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

Under USATT Safe Sport Policy, persons holding certain **Positions of Authority** must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for Safe Sport (once per year) and undergo a criminal background screen (every two years). The list of Positions of Authority requiring **Full Safe Sport Compliance** is set out in USATT's Safe Sport Policy and the Athlete Safety Section of the USATT Website: https://www.teamusa.org/usa-table-tennis/athlete-safety/safe-sport.

USATT COACHING POLICY

All persons who are engaged in **coaching activities** at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT Sanctioned Tournaments, **except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children**, must be **Fully Safe Sport Compliant**, which requires completing SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.

ADULT PARTICIPANTS REQUIRING SAFESPORT TRAINING

Pursuant to USATT's Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy, <u>ALL Adult Participants</u> (participants over the age of 18) who have regular contact with or authority over minor aged athletes must complete SafeSport Training offered by the US Center for SafeSport every year ("SafeSport Trained").

CONTACT USATT TO BECOME SAFESPORT TRAINED AND/OR FULLY SAFE SPORT COMPLIANT

USATT is pleased to assist USATT Members in the process of becoming SafeSport Trained and/or Fully Safe Sport Compliant. Please contact USATT at Admin@usatt.org for more information and guidance in this process.

MANDATORY REPORTING

There are certain circumstances where **reporting a potential Safe Sport violation is mandatory**. These circumstances include: (i) child abuse; (ii) sexual misconduct; (iii) emotional and physical misconduct; (iv) criminal charges and/or dispositions involving sexual misconduct or misconduct involving minors; (v) any abuse of the Safe Sport process. **Child abuse must be immediately reported to local law enforcement.** To learn more about the appropriate agency where you can submit a report of child abuse, log onto: https://www.childwelfare.gov/topics/responding/reporting.
