

2025 Synchronized Diving Camp

Athlete Selection Criteria

Overview:

Camp invitations will be extended in priority order according to the criteria below. Athletes already invited under an earlier criterion are omitted from subsequent lists. In addition to these criteria, USA Diving reserves the right to extend further invitations as needed (see Section 6).

General Eligibility

Every candidate for the 2025 Synchronized Diving Camp must, by the time determined by the High Performance Director:

- Be a citizen of the United States,
- Be a member in good standing of USA Diving,
- Comply with the USA Diving Athlete Agreement,
- Comply with the USA Diving Code of Conduct,
- Comply with the USA Diving SafeSport Policy,
- Must be actively training for diving.

1. Degree-of-Difficulty Minimum Achievers

Any synchronized diving team that meets or exceeds the prescribed DD minimum at the 2025 AQUA World Cup Series, USA Diving National Championships, or World Aquatics Recognized events will receive an invitation.

Women's 10 m Synchro	13
Men's 3 m Synchro	17.8
Men's 10 m Synchro	17.9

2. Top Two Teams at 2025 USA Diving National Championships

(Excluding any team already invited under Section 1)

3. Medalists in Synchronized Events at 2025 AQUA World Cups & Recognized Meets

(Excluding any team already invited under Sections 1–2)

4. Members of the 2025 World Aquatics Championships Team

(Olympic-event squad members, not already invited under Sections 1–3)

5. Medalists in Individual Events at 2025 AQUA World Cups & Recognized Meets

(Not already invited under Sections 1–4)

6. Additional Invitations

- Replacement Invitations: If any athlete or team invited under Sections 1–6 declines, USA Diving may extend invitations to the next-ranked athlete(s) or pairing(s) based on performance and event needs.
- **Discretionary Invitations:** USA Diving also reserves the right to invite additional athletes or newly formed synchronized diving pairings (e.g. from the Junior Pan American Games) at the discretion of the High Performance Director, regardless of whether declines occur.
