ENTRANCE CRITERIAS

Every diving federation will establish its unique set of criteria for participant selection in this competition. To inquire about the requirements for entry, please consult your respective National Sports Federation (NSF). Before the competition, every athlete is obligated to successfully execute and showcase all their dives. Additionally, they must obtain safety certification from the competition management team in order to be eligible for participation. Failure to fulfill these prerequisites will lead to disqualification without the possibility of reimbursement.

**PLEASE NOTE: Access to the 15m and higher platforms is granted on a case-by-case basis and can be rescinded at any point if safety concerns arise. USA Diving and the Fort Lauderdale Aquatic Center reserve the right to permit or deny access to participants, even if an athlete has been deemed "Safe to Compete."

RULE REMINDER FOR GROUPS IN HIGH DIVING...

The dives are divided into five (5) groups. The first digit (or the first two digits) shall indicate the group to which the dive belongs:

- Front and front twist: 1 or 51
- Back and back twist: 2 or 52
- Reverse and reverse twist: 3 or 53
- Inward and inward twist: 4 or 54
- Armstand and armstand twist: 6

COMPETITION FORMAT

This competition will be split in two days.

- Day 1 = 1 Required Dive + 1 Optional
 - \circ $\;$ The order of diving will be determined by a random draw.
- Days 2 = 1 Intermediate + 1 Optional
 - The 3rd and 4th (last) round of dives will be performed in the reverse order of the ranking at the end of the previous round.

AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS

We request that divers be dressed in <u>full team uniform or club jacket</u> for <u>awards ceremonies and</u> <u>marshalling for Finals</u>, <u>towels are not permitted</u>. 
AIRPORT ⇔ HOTEL/POOL
