2023 USA Diving Winter National Championships

Qualification Criteria and Team Selections November 28-December 6, 2023 Allan Jones Aquatic Center Knoxville, TN

Clerical Amendment- Sept 19, 2023

USA Diving will host the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championships in Knoxville, TN. This premier competition will see participation from the top athletes in the United States and will contest spots for the 2023 World Championships, as well as any additional international teams as decided by the High Performance Director.

Please note: The USA Diving Winter National Championship is a national team qualifying event, thereby meeting the criteria of NCAA bylaw <u>16.8.1.2 (a).</u>

Team and Squad selections

- a. 2024 World Championships
- b. Additional events as decided by the High Performance Department

Contested events

- a. 3-meter, 10-meter (preliminaries, semi-finals, and finals)
- b. 1-meter, Synchronized 3-meter, Synchronized 10-meter (prelims and finals)
- c. Mixed Synchronized 3-meter, 10-meter (finals)

Entry deadline: Registration will be done through Divemeets.com. All Athletes, Coaches, Staff and other Participants must have Eligible USA Diving memberships. Late fees will go into effect at 5 p.m. ET on Tuesday, November 15, 2023. Online registration will still be available after 5 p.m. ET on Tuesday, November 15, 2023, with a \$100/diver late fee.

ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE

Individual Events (U.S. Citizens)

Diver must:

- a. Be a member in good standing of USA Diving
- b. Meet the standards for eligibility to compete

Qualification Criteria:

- a. Current Senior High Performance Squad Members (Tier I, II, and III) in any event
- b. Current High Performance Squad Tier III Junior Members who meet the following:
 - i. On 1-meter and 3-meter springboard events, Junior Tier III Members must meet the minimum

degree of difficulty requirements

ii. On platform, Junior Tier III Members must perform all dives from the 10-meter platform, but do not need to meet the minimum degree of difficulty requirement. Junior divers registering with voluntaries who do not meet the minimum DD should sign up with an incorrect list and email <u>oliviar@usadiving.org</u>.

*No more than two voluntary dives may be included in the diver's list.

- c. Divers will be eligible to compete in a specific event provided that they have achieved the minimum score listed in Table 1 at one of the competitions listed in Table 2. This includes the Winter Nationals Qualifier occurring November 28-30, 2023.
 - i. Divers do not need to meet the minimum degree of difficulty when obtaining the qualifying score, but must meet the DD requirements outlined below at the 2023 Winter Nationals
 - Divers at NCAA events or Junior Nationals (Group A and B optionals only) do not need to perform all dives on 10-meter when obtaining the qualifying score on platform, but must compete all dives from the 10-meter at the 2023 Winter Nationals (to be considered for team selection, divers MUST meet the degree of difficulty requirements)

Athletes may participate <u>only</u> in the event(s) that they have qualified for. Athletes wishing to qualify for additional events may participate in preliminary events at the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championship Qualifier, which will take place from November 28-30, 2023.

The list of Qualified Athletes based on the above Criteria can be found on DiveMeets.

Individual Events (Non-U.S. Citizens)

Divers must:

- a. Meet qualification criteria and standards of eligibility to compete
- b. Be a member in good standing of their home federation and have permission from their federation to compete. A request from the Federation must be submitted to Olivia Rosendahl (<u>oliviar@usadiving.org</u>) for approval. All requests received by 5 p.m. ET on November 1, 2023 will receive full consideration for approval; any requests received after the deadline will be subject to review at USA Diving's discretion
- c. Be a current USA Diving member in good standing

Qualification Criteria:

- a. Divers will be eligible to compete in a specific event provided that they have achieved the minimum score in Table 1 at one of the following events:
 - i. 2022 or 2023 NCAA Division I Zone, NCAA National Championships, or approved Conference Championships
 - ii. Home country's National Championships (2022 or 2023)
 - iii. 2021, 2022, or 2023 FINA/World Aquatics Event (Grand Prix, World Series, World Championship, World Cup, World Cup Series, or Olympic Games)
- b. If the score was achieved at a.) ii/iii above, the diver must submit proof of score by 5 p.m. ET on November 1, 2023 to Olivia Rosendahl (<u>oliviar@usadiving.org</u>)
- c. Divers do not need to meet the minimum degree of difficulty when obtaining the qualifying score, but must meet the DD requirements outlined below at the 2023 Winter Nationals
- d. Divers at NCAA meets do not need to perform all dives on 10-meter when obtaining the qualifying score, but must compete all dives from 10-meter at the 2023 Winter Nationals

Synchronized Events (U.S. Citizens)

Both divers must:

- a. Be citizens of the United States
- b. Be members of good standing of USA Diving
- c. Meet minimum degree of difficulty standards outlined in Table 4 below

*Divers may compete with up to two partners per event

Synchronized Events (Non-U.S. Citizens)

Both divers must:

- a. Be citizens of the same country
- b. Have permission from their home federation to compete in the USA Diving Winter Nationals. A request from the federation must be submitted to Olivia Rosendahl (<u>oliviar@usadiving.org</u>) for approval. All requests received by 5 p.m. ET on November 1, 2023 will receive full consideration for approval; any requests received after the deadline will be subject to review at USA Diving's discretion
- c. Meet minimum degree of difficulty standards outlined in Table 4 below
- d. Be members in good standing of USA Diving

International and Junior (10-meter) Athletes Advancement to Semifinals and Finals

International divers and Junior athletes (who do not meet the DD requirements in the 10-meter event) may progress from the preliminaries to the semi-finals, to the Finals; however, the Semi-Final events shall be capped at 22 athletes and the final events shall be capped at 14 athletes. **1-meter:** No more than two international athletes who place in the top eight will advance from preliminaries to finals. **3-meter:** No more than four international athletes who place in the top 18 will advance from preliminaries to semi-finals and no more than two who place in the top 12 will advance from semi-finals to finals. **10-meter:** No more than four international or junior divers (not meeting the DD requirements) who place in the top 18 will advance from the preliminaries to the semi-finals and no more than two who place in the top 12 will advance from the semi-finals and no more than two belace in the top 12 will advance from the preliminaries to the semi-finals and no more than two who place in the top 12 will advance from the preliminaries to the semi-finals and no more than two who place in the top 12 will advance from the preliminaries to the semi-finals and no more than two who place in the top 12 will advance from the preliminaries to the semi-finals and no more than two who place in the top 12 will advance from the semi-finals to the finals.

*Note: International divers will be eligible to receive a place finish but will not displace a U.S. diver from finaling or earning a medal.

CONTESTED EVENTS

Women's 1-Meter (Preliminary & Final)

Divers will perform 5 dives in the Preliminary, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 11.9.

Top 8 athletes will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Preliminary and Final.

Women's 3-Meter (Preliminary, Semi-Final & Final)

Divers will perform 5 dives in the Preliminary, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 13.7.

Top 18 will progress to the Semi-Final from the Preliminary. Scores will begin at 0 in the Semi-Final round.

Top 12 based on scores from the Semi-Final will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Semi-Final and Final.

Women's 10-Meter (Preliminary, Semi-Final & Final)

Divers will perform 5 dives in the Preliminary, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 13.3.

Top 18 will progress to the Semi-Final from the Preliminary. Scores will begin at 0 in the Semi-Final round.

Top 12 based on scores from the Semi-Final will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Semi-Final and Final.

*<u>Please Note</u>: Junior divers must perform all dives from 10-meter, but do not need to meet the minimum DD requirements. No more than TWO voluntary dives may be included in the junior diver's list. To be considered for team selection, divers MUST meet the degree of difficulty requirements.

Men's 1-Meter (Preliminary & Final)

Divers will perform 6 dives in the Preliminary, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 15.9.

Top 8 athletes will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Preliminary and Final.

Men's 3-Meter (Preliminary, Semi-Final & Final)

Divers will perform 6 dives in the Preliminary, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 17.2.

Top 18 will progress to the Semi-Final from the Preliminary. Scores will begin at 0 in the Semi-Final round.

Top 12 based on scores from the Semi-Final will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Semi-Final and Final.

Men's 10-Meter (Preliminary, Semi-Final & Final)

Divers will perform 6 dives in the Preliminary, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 17.1.

Top 18 will progress to the Semi-Final from the Preliminary. Scores will begin at 0 in the Semi-Final round.

Top 12 based on scores from the Semi-Final will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Semi-Final and Final.

*<u>Please Note</u>: Junior divers must perform all dives from 10-meter, but do not need to meet the minimum DD requirements. No more than TWO voluntary dives may be included in the junior diver's list. To be considered for team selection, divers MUST meet the degree of difficulty requirements.

Women's Synchronized 3-Meter (Preliminary & Final)

Divers will perform 5 dives as a pair, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 12.3, where the first 2 dives are voluntaries at a fixed Degree of Difficulty (2.0).

Top 12 will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Prelim and Final.

Women's Synchronized 10-Meter (Preliminary & Final)

Divers will perform 5 dives as a pair, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 12.2, where the first 2 dives are voluntaries at a fixed Degree of Difficulty (2.0).

Top 12 will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Prelim and Final.

Men's Synchronized 3-Meter (Preliminary & Final)

Divers will perform 6 dives as a pair, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 15.7, where the first 2 dives are voluntaries at a fixed Degree of Difficulty (2.0).

Top 12 will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Prelim and Final.

Men's Synchronized 10-Meter (Preliminary & Final)

Divers will perform 6 dives as a pair, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 15.9, where the first 2 dives are voluntaries at a fixed Degree of Difficulty (2.0).

Top 12 will progress to the Final.

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined by the accumulation of total points scored in the Prelim and Final.

Mixed Synchronized 3-Meter and 10-Meter (Final Only)

Divers will perform 5 dives as a pair, with a minimum cumulative D.D. of 12.8 (3M) & 13.0 (10M), where the first 2 dives are voluntaries at a fixed Degree of Difficulty (2.0).

The ranking of the finalists shall be determined from the total points in the Finals.
