**QUALIFICATION SYSTEM PAN AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**2024 ITTF Pan American Championships:**

- Winner and Runner 2023 ITTF Pan American Championships
- 6 Players North America
- 12 Players Central America
- 16 Players Caribbean
- 16 Players South America
- 4 Players host country
- 8 Players by World Ranking week 30 (as special exception for 2024, these 8 players do not need to attend the regional event)

**Procedure for this qualification system:**

**First Step:** 2023 ITTF Pan American Championships: 2 players

**Second Step:** Players qualified by region: 50 Players (In the case a regional event doesn't run for any reason, players for this region going be selected by WR taking players' only for the region)

**Third Step:** Host countries players: 4 Players

**Fourth Step:** World Ranking 8 players week 30 (no more than 2 players by MA)

**Total Players:** 64 Players

The list with the players qualified for this event will be published 2 months before the event, All the regions need to confirm the list of qualifiers immediately finish the regional championships.

#### **Note:**

- Up to 4 players can qualify per Member Association to the 2024 ITTF Pan American Championship.
- Is not allowed to enter more than 2 players by WR.
- The qualification is by player and the member association cannot replace the player qualified by another player.
- In the case that a Member Association has a player who is qualified by world ranking after the completion of all regional events (within the top 8 ranked players of the continent) and has qualified 4 players in the regional event. The Member Association may substitute up to 1 player from the list of qualified players, this must be reported to ITTF-Americas not later than 15 days after the week 30, otherwise the list of officially qualified players will be published, and no substitution can be made.
- All players need to qualify following the qualification system established in this document.

#### **Continental Event information:**

##### **Doubles Event**

Member Associations can select the doubles players from the qualified singles players (from the total 64 player)

##### **Team event**

The teams will be formed with the qualified players, in case not completing 16 teams, more teams will be invited following the August World Team Ranking, however the players of these teams may not participate in the singles event, or doubles, in case any country only has 3 qualified players and participate in teams, this country can bring a fourth player who could only participate in this event (Teams).

**QUALIFICATION SYSTEM PAN AMERICAN YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**2024 Pan American Youth Championships (U15 & U19):**

- 2 Teams North America
- 4 Teams Central America
- 4 Teams Caribbean
- 4 Teams South America
- 1 host
- 1 World Team Ranking (U15 & U19) – Must play in the regional event

**Procedure for this qualification system:**

**First Step:** Teams qualify by Region: 14 Teams

**Second Step:** Host Team: 1 Team

**Third Step:** World Team Ranking: 1 Team

**Total Teams:** 16 Teams

The list with the Teams qualified for this event will be published 2 months before the event.

**QUALIFICATION SYSTEM PAN AMERICAN U11 & U13 CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**2024 Pan American U11 & U13 Championships:**

**Procedure for this qualification system:**

**Total Teams:** Unlimited

**Requirement:** For a national association to be eligible to participate in the 2024 Pan American U11 & U13 Championships, it is a prerequisite that the association has participated in the regional event with at least one player per category, irrespective of gender

In the exceptional case that the regional event does not take place due to circumstances beyond the control of the countries, or if the event occurs within 30 days before the Pan American Championship, the players from this region will be exempt of this rule.
