#### RULES AND CURRENT IJF RULES:

Current IJF contest rules will be used with the following modifications: CARE System will not be in effect and three referees will be used as a modification. For Juvenile, Cadet, and IJF Junior ages, mat size will be 8 x 8 meters with 4 meter safety zone. True Double Elimination for groups of more than 5 players; Round Robin for groups of 5 or fewer. Round robin places will be determined by the following criteria, in descending order: number of wins, points, head to head result. (Wins by ippon=10 points, win by wazari=5 points)

Full IJF rules with standard USA Judo modifications. Shimewaza allowed in Juvenile Divisions. Shimewaza, Kansetsuwaza allowed in Cadet and IJF Junior Divisions

Competition Divisions: We will have separate male and female Intermediate, Juvenile, Cadet and IJF divisions. Each athlete may play in up to two divisions; first division must be the true age and weight; second division can be one age and/or weight division up. Novice athletes can also enter regular division as their second division. Weight divisions will be light/middle/heavy and determined based on participating competitors' weights. Age divisions are based on year of birth:

All Novice match duration will be 3 min with 2 min Golden Score. Regular Juvenile. matches will be 3 min with 2 min Golden Score; Regular Cadet and IJF matches will be 4 min with 3 min Golden Score. For matches that go to the limit of Golden Score in round robin divisions, the result will be a draw (hike wake) with no points given to either player. For double elimination brackets, winner will be determined by Hantei.

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded to first, second, and third place. Promotion points can be earned in the Cadet and IJF Junior division.

Head Referees: Mr. Scott Morifuji. Referee volunteers are welcome; coaches, fans and spectators are also welcome
