WORLD SKATE RANKING:

World Skate Artistic Technical Commission has included the Americas Cup Championship of Clubs in the World Ranking. The Ranking will be for Junior and Senior skaters in Free Skating, Pairs, Solo Dance, and Couples Dance. Only the top 3 competitors from each country will be eligible for ranking.

TRANSPORTATION AND ACCOMMODATION:

Each club will be responsible for their own transportation and lodging. There are many low and moderate price hotel and family home accommodations in the area







JUDGES:

World Skate Artistic Technical Commission will select the Judges.

Each Federation may send a maximum of two (2) World Skate Artistic Judges. Additional Judges will be provided by the USA Roller Sports. Judges Panel and Technical Panel will be all World Skate certified. Each judge is responsible for their own travel cost to the USA. Hotel accommodations, internal transport, and per diem for food during the Championship will be provided by the organizers.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE:

Saturday, January 18 Day of Registration and Coaches Meeting Sunday, January 19 Training and Competition 5am to 11pm Monday, January 20 Training and Competition 5am to 11pm Tuesday, January 21 Training and Competition 5am to 11pm Wednesday, January 22 Training and Competition 5am to 11pm Thursday, January 23 Competition and Closing 5am to 5pm

AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in all competitions (gold, silver & bronze). Trophies for the top three clubs that occupy the highest score awarded based on the points by competition in each international category, as follows:

Ist place: 15 points, 2nd place: 12 points, 3rd place: 10 points, 4th place: 8 points, 5th place: 6 points, 6th place: 5 points, 7th place: 4 points, 8th place: 3 points, 9th place: 2 points, 10th place: 1 point. The Club receiving the highest accumulation of points will be awarded the Americas Cup Championship Trophy of Clubs.

SKATING REQUIREMENTS

All events will follow the World Skate 2025 Requirements for International and Promotional events.

The Figure Group will be drawn on December 20, 2024, from the World Skate Requirements. Figures will be drawn in the order as listed in the requirements; however, the loop will be skated last in all events. The figure direction (foot) will be drawn by January 5, 2025, and the figure draw will be posted on our website.







DEVELOPMENTAL EVENTS:

Developmental events will be offered at the conclusion of the Official Cup events. These events may be judged by Regional and National USA Judges. Developmental events will not be included in the calculation of the high point awards.

Developmental Figure Requirements: Developmental Figures all ages – Divisions will be determined after entries are received Developmental Figures Level One – 1b (Change eight -S) and 2 Developmental Figures Level Two – 8a/b and 9a/b Developmental Figures Level Three – 10 and 12

Developmental – Free Skating Divisions will be determined after entries are received Developmental Free Skating ages Espoir and above Developmental Free Skating – Will follow WS Promotional Mini Basic
