## **FACILITY AND EQUIPMENT**

Pool Equipment: Full stack tower - 3M, 5M, 7.5M, 10M

Two concrete 1-M, two concrete 3-M, two auxiliary 1-M's, two auxiliary 3-M's

Dryland Equipment: Three dry boards, five trampolines (two with belts) and a floor area.

## **REGISTRATION**

All participants must be "Current" members of USA Diving. All athlete and coach entries must be made online at [www.divemeets.com](http://www.divemeets.com) prior to June 14 at 11:59 PM EST. No athlete or coach will be permitted access to the pool deck without having completed their DiveMeets registration. Athletes may still register after the deadline up until three hours prior to their event with an added \$100 Late Registration fee. **As of the 2026 season, coaches who miss the online registration deadline will incur a \$50 Late Registration fee, which must be paid prior to deck authorization.**

## **DIVE CHANGES**

All dive changes, including payment, MUST be made online through DiveMeets. Athletes may log into their DiveMeets account to review and update their dive sheets within the timeline outlined below:

1. Changes may be made online at no cost before 6:00 PM the night prior to the first day's events, and before 12:00 PM the day prior to all competition days thereafter.
2. After the designated times in point 1, athletes may make changes to their dive sheets online at a cost of \$15 per event up until three hours prior to their event start time.
3. Dive changes will no longer be accepted three hours prior to the corresponding event.

## **PARTICIPANT COMPORTMENT**

USA Diving promotes good sportsmanship from athletes, coaches and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racist or sexist comments, or other intimidating actions directed at judges, meet personnel, athletes, coaches, spectators, or team representatives are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing or bullying, and acts of cyberbullying by members towards any member is strictly prohibited. Retaliation against any person who reports, is thought to have reported, files a complaint or otherwise participates in an investigation or inquiry is also strictly prohibited. False charges shall also be regarded as a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action or other appropriate sanctions. Persons whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. USA Diving may also make referrals to law enforcement officials.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.

## **TECHNICAL MEETING**

The Technical Meeting will be conducted in person on Wednesday, June 24. The meeting time will be communicated at a later date.

Attendance at the Technical Meeting is mandatory for all coaches in order to receive pool deck access for the competition.

Failure to attend the meeting may result in denial of deck credentials per article 106.9 of the 2026 USA Diving Official Rulebook.

## **JUDGING**

The competition will be attended by one AQUA-Certified USA Diving Judge to serve as a Head Referee of the event and two AQUA-Certified USA Diving Judges to serve as Assistant Referees.

## **CHECK-IN TABLE**

The check-in table will be located at the front of COM at the front desk/lobby.

## **RESTROOMS**

Athletes - Located in the locker rooms available in the hallway by the pool.

Coaches/Staff/Adults - Located in the front lobby or through the Doss room (hospitality).

Spectators - Located in the front lobby.

## **FIRST AID/MEDICAL SERVICES**

Certified lifeguards will be on duty throughout the competition. The lifeguards on duty are the primary first responders for all in-water emergencies and first aid situations. First aid services are located behind the curtain in the back corner of the facility by the meet operations room. In the event of an emergency, all participants, coaches, and spectators should immediately notify the nearest lifeguard and follow their instructions.

## **ATHLETIC TRAINING/PHYSIOTHERAPY**

No athletic training and/or physiotherapy services will be provided.

## **COACH HOSPITALITY**

Coach hospitality will be available in the Doss room- snacks and drinks will be offered throughout the day with meals depending on the timeline.
