

EXPLANATION OF CCP LEVELS

AS OF OCTOBER, 2025

COACH CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

All USAAS Certifications can be found at [USAAS Academy](#)

Each certification is good for 4 years. To maintain your CCP Level, you must do one of the following:

- Complete the level you are at currently.
- Complete the next level up (note: Level 3 is the highest level).
- Attend Coaches College, or any other requirement/event approved by the USAAS Chief of Sport. The expiration date will be extended one year.

If your expiration date for your CCP is December 2025, you must do one of the above before the end of the year. If you fail to renew by your expiration date, your certification will lapse, and you will be required to start over from the beginning.

CCP REQUIREMENTS

CCP Level 1 – Required for all coaches to be on deck at any land or water training or sanctioned competition. Exception: Skills Specialists as defined in Appendix C. No emergency waiver is allowed.

CCP Levels 1 & 2 – Required for all coaches to be on deck at any Regional or Zone Championship. Exception: A one-time emergency waiver for Level 2 will only be given in the case of an emergency and with the approval of the USAAS Chief of Sport.

CCP 3 – Required for all coaches to be on deck at National Championship. Exception: Exception: A one-time emergency waiver for Level 3 will only be given in the case of an emergency and with the approval of the USAAS Chief of Sport.

Properly submitted:

- Safety credentials (Current CPR/First Aid).
- National Center for Safety Initiatives (“NCSI”) Background Check (parental consent required for minors under 18 years of age).
- Current SafeSport training – Required for all coaches to be on deck at any time.

LEVEL 1 CCP COURSE

The Level 1 course is an online course. It can be find at USAAS Academy [Here](#)
The certificates will automatically be registered with USAAS at Sport:80 profile.

- The cost for Level 1 is \$125.00
- There will be a 30-day time limit to complete the course.
- The Level 1 Course takes approximately 2-1/2 hours to complete.
- A Level 1 Certificate Badge will be assigned to the member Sport:80 account upon completion of the course and all requirements are met. .

The Level 1 course is intended as a starting point for coaches. It confirms to the organization, other coaches, judges, and athletes that all coaches have had exposure to a general coaching curriculum. It covers specific artistic swimming fundamentals, safety/risk management, ethics, and general training. The Level 1 course creates a common base for all coaches including a new coach just starting out up to the most experienced national level coach.

- Physical Fitness & Training Components
- Annual Training Plan and Phases
- Risk Management
- Code of Ethics
- Basic Figure Information
- Basic Routine Information and Choreography

Requirements for Certification:

- Minimum 15 years of age.
- Membership: USAAS Youth or Adult Instructor, Youth or Adult Professional, Youth or Adult Competitive Athlete, Youth or Adult Athlete or Youth or Adult Life membership required.
- First Aid and CPR certificates
- NCSI Background Check (parental consent required for minors under 18 years of age)
- SafeSport certificate
- Pass an open book online exam.



LEVEL 2 CCP COURSE

Level 2 course is an online course. It can be find at USAAS Academy [Here](#)
The certificates will automatically be registered with USAAS at Sport:80 profile.

- The cost for Level 2 is \$125.00
- There will be a 30-day time limit to complete the course.
- The Level 2 Course takes approximately 2-1/2 hours to complete.
- A Level 2 Certificate Badge will be assigned to the member Sport:80 account upon completion of the course and all requirements are met. .

The Level 2 course is intended to give coaches an overall exposure to the sport of artistic swimming. The coach will be able to instruct fundamentals, provide teaching progressions, create daily lesson plans, and write and teach routines. The Level 2 course provides valuable information that will continue the coach's development.

- Membership: USAAS Youth or Adult Professional or Youth or Adult Life Membership required.
- First Aid and CPR certificates

- SafeSport certificate
- Must have previously completed Level 1 CCP.
- Pass an open book online exam.



LEVEL 3 CCP COURSE

- The cost for Level 3 is \$125.00
- There will be a 30-day time limit to complete the course.
- The Level 3 Course takes approximately 2-1/2 hours to complete.
- A Level 3 Certificate Badge will be assigned to the member Sport:80 account upon completion of the course and all requirements are met.

The Level 3 course is intended to give coaches the opportunity to learn about very specific topics that will continue to develop the knowledge of the coach in the sport of artistic swimming

- Pass an open book online exam.
