






CENTRAL & NORTH HALL | LEVEL 1



Floor Plan


- Everyone will enter the lobby area
- The FOP and event will take place in Hall N3
- There are escalators outside of Hall N3 up to the 2nd floor
- Check In will take place in rm N256
- There is a Skybridge from the Westgate (Host Hotel) to the LVCC

Schematic Weigh In Flow


- Boxers ONLY boxing in that day's session will enter and go to the bleachers
- Once called by officials, they will weigh in at the Gloving Area
- After Successful weigh in they will receive their session passes (1 Boxer 3 Coaches)
- Will exit out of the Session Pass Entrance and into the Coaches Space



2025 USA Boxing JOs & SF – Weigh In Process

- Trial Scales will open daily at 5:00am on Competition Days
- Daily Weigh Ins will begin at 6:00am Sharp
- NO General weigh in
- Boxers will ONLY be required to weigh in on the days that they compete
- Boxers MUST use the trial scale prior to official weigh in
- NO Skipping places in line
- Listen to Officials and staff to ensure a smooth process
- Following Weigh In Boxers will receive that sessions' session pass
 - 1 Boxer and 3 Coaches per boxer





Schematic Competition Flow

- Boxers and Coaches will enter the Coaches Area to wrap hands and warm up
- The Session Pass entrance will be allowing up to 3 bouts per ring back to the gloving area
- Please have your Session
 Passes ready and entire party
 (1 Boxer & up to 3 coaches)
 there when you enter
- Boxers will then go to gloving area to receive gloves for bout
- Boxers and Coaches will proceed to their ring
- All Boxers and Coaches must exit out following the bout and MUST not double back to gloving area

2025 USA Boxing JOs & SF - Session Pass Flow

- Boxers and Coaches will be let into the Session Pass entrance up to 3 bouts at a time
- STRICT ADHERANCE to the Session Pass attendant
- NOON and 6pm Start SHARP
- Please have all coaches and boxer for the designated bout as a group
- Walkover if late and miss bout
- On Deck
- 1 Way traffic flow, NO RETURNS to Gloving Area
- Please treat the attendants and security with respect. What they say goes. NO PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT



2025 USA Boxing JOs & SF - Glove Table

- Once through the Session Pass Table you will head to the Glove Table
- There you will tell them your bout, and they will provide you with the gloves for your bout
- Glove Table officials will sign off on your hand wraps
- USAB will have RED and BLUE Sting headgear to rent if you don't have it
 - You will just need to provide an ID to the Glove Table
 - Once finished with your bout please exit to the license table where you will pick up your ID and return your headgear
- NO Exit out of Gloving Area once you receive your gloves



Areas of Access

North Hall 3

- All credentialed and wrist banded can be in the hall
- Will have ticket takers/security checking credentials or daily/weekly wristbands for entrance into the hall
- Boxers will have access to the Trial Scales and Coaches Space during scheduled times (Check Schedule)
- Coaches', Boxers, Parents, and others will have access to the bleachers/seating and Vendor areas


Coaches' Space

- Boxers and Coaches' ONLY in this area
 - MUST have credential to be allowed in the Coaches' Space Boxer or Coach


Coaches Space

Please adhere to the Coaches Space Rules at ALL Times

- ONLY BOXERS & COACHES with CREDENTIAL allowed into Coaches Space
- Security and Attendants will be monitoring the Coaches Area
 - NO RECORDING at ANY TIME
 - ONLY 2 Boxers in the ring at a time
 - ONLY 1 Person on the Apron at a time
 - Failure to adhere to these rules could result in Credential Confiscation
- The Coaches Space is the coaches' job to police. Please treat it as your own gym
- There will be plenty of chairs in the coaches' space to wrap hands



Athlete Parade & Opening Ceremonies



- Opening Ceremonies/Parade will take place on Sunday June 15th at NOON
- Participants will gather in the Hall N2 at 11:15am in their respective LBCs
- Staff and Security will place people in their LBCs
- Each LBC will take a team
 Photo in front of the Step and
 Repeat
- Following the Photo boxers will file into the bleachers as the LBC and around the ring
