MANUAL THERAPY AND THERAPUTIC AND RECOVERY MODALITIES

OBSERVABLE AND INTERRUPTIBLE

All athletic training modalities must take place in a location where individuals can walk by and observe what is occurring and interrupt if necessary.

TWO ADULT PARTICIPANTS PRESENT

A second Adult Participant must be present in the room. An adult participant located outside of the room or in an adjacent room does not meet this standard.¹

¹.Adult Participant: Adult (18 yrs of age or older) such as, a coach, official, staff or BOD member

ONE-ON-ONE INTERACTIONS

MINOR/ADULT INTERACTIONS:

Must be **observable and interruptible**

HEALTH PROFESSIONAL MEETINGS:

- Need legal guardian consent
- Door can be closed but must be unlocked
- Another adult must be present at the facility and aware of the meeting

INDIVIDUAL TRAINING SESSIONS:

- **Observable and Interruptible**
- Written consent required at least annually

LOCKER ROOMS AND CHANGING AREAS

RECORDING DEVICES

Recording devices are not allowed in locker rooms without USA Boxing's prior approval and only in specific circumstances and when all athletes are fully clothed.

MONITORING

USA Boxing must complete regular and random monitoring of locker rooms and changing areas.

UNDRESS

Unrelated Adult Participants must not intentionally expose his/her breast, buttocks, groin, or genitals to a minor athlete.

LODGING

COMPETITION TRAVEL

Legal consent is needed for any one-on-one travel involving an Adult Participant and one minor athlete.

HOTEL ROOMS

An Adult Participant cannot share a hotel room or otherwise sleep in the same room with a Minor Athlete(s), unless an exception exists and the Minor Athlete's parent/guardian has provided USA Boxing, its LBCs or Clubs or Adult Participant with advance, written consent for each specific lodging arrangement.

MEETINGS

Meetings during travel must be **observable and interruptible**.

SOCIAL MEDIA AND ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS

ALL electronic communication from Adult Participants to minor athletes must be professional in nature.

A second Adult Participant or parent/legal guardian must be copied on all communication between minor athletes and Adult Participant.

Parents/ legal guardians can request to discontinue communication to their minor athlete except in emergency circumstances.

TRANSPORTATION

Adult Participants not acting as a legal guardian may not ride alone in a vehicle with an unrelated minor athlete without prior consent.

Unrelated Adult Participants must always have at least two minor athletes or another adult in a vehicle,

Written legal guardian consent must be obtained prior to each local travel for an Adult Participant one-on-one in a vehicle with an unrelated minor athlete.
