Clubs inside the USA – All skaters must be members of USA Roller Sports in good standing. Clubs outside the USA – All clubs must obtain and provide a letter from their Federation that includes all the names of the athletes and coaches attending the Americas Cup stating that they are members of the Federation that is affiliated with World Skate and that each person listed is a member of the Federation.

World Skate Rule 2.5 World Skate OPEN Competitions: For World Skate Open
Competitions where clubs can directly enter skaters it is required that the Organizing
Committees check that the club is affiliated with a World Skate National Federation.
Skaters must be confirmed by the National Federation or directly entered by their
National Federation.

WORLD SKATE RANKING:

World Skate Artistic Technical Commission has included the Americas Cup Championship of Clubs in the World Ranking. The Ranking will be for Junior and Senior skaters in Free Skating, Pairs, Solo Dance, and Couples Dance. Only the top 3 competitors from each country will be eligible for ranking.

TRANSPORTATION AND ACCOMMODATION:

Local International Airport: MCO - Orlando International Airport

Each club will be responsible for their own transportation and lodging. There are many low and moderate price hotel and family home accommodations in the area

JUDGES INTERNATIONAL EVENTS:

World Skate Artistic Technical Commission will select the Judges.

Judges Panel and Technical Panel will be all World Skate certified.

Each judge is responsible for their own travel cost to the USA. Hotel accommodations, internal transport, and per diem for food during the Championship will be provided by the organizers.

AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in all competitions (gold, silver & bronze).

Trophies for the top three clubs that occupy the highest score awarded based on the points by competition in each international category, as follows:

Ist place: 15 points, 2nd place: 12 points, 3rd place: 10 points, 4th place: 8 points, 5th place: 6 points, 6th place: 5 points, 7th place: 4 points, 8th place: 3 points, 9th place: 2 points, 10th place: 1 point.

The Club receiving the highest accumulation of points will be awarded the Americas Cup Championship Trophy of Clubs.

SKATING REQUIREMENTS

All events will follow the World Skate 2026 Requirements for International and Promotional events.

The Figure Group will be drawn on December 20, 2025, from the World Skate Requirements. Figures will be drawn in the order as listed in the requirements; however, **the loop will be skated last in all events.** The figure direction (foot) will be drawn by January 5, 2026, and the figure draw will be posted on USA Roller Sports website. Men and Women will have the same figure draw, these events will be skated together and judged separately.

DEVELOPMENTAL EVENTS:

Developmental events will be offered on Saturday, January 17, 2026, before the Official Cup events. These events may be judged by Regional and National USA Judges. Developmental events will not be included in the calculation of the high point awards.

Developmental Figure Requirements:

All Developmental Figure events will do two (2) repetitions.

Developmental Figures all ages - Age Divisions will be determined after entries are received

Developmental Figures Level One – 1b (Change eight -S) and 2

Developmental Figures Level Two - 8a/b and 9a/b

Developmental Figures Level Three - 10 and 12

Developmental - Free Skating

Age Divisions will be determined after entries are received

Developmental Level One Free Skating – Will follow WS Promotional Mini Basic rules
Developmental Level Two Free Skating - Will follow WS Promotional Mini Intermediate rules
