Fellow members of USA Judo.

I have been nominated by current and former athletes to run as an Athlete Representative for the Kata Committee. I am honored to be recognized. While Shiai receives more publicity, competition is equally important. Working with a partner requires teamwork and cooperation. Kata allows judoka to understand and hone valuable skills that translates into Shiai and later in their careers as coaches for upand-coming athletes.

My experience as a kata competitor has included winning at state and national championships in kata, competing in two Pan American Kata Championships and one World Kata Championship. In addition, I successfully passed the Kodokan Kata Course and was certified in Katame-No-Kata in 2025. These experiences have provided me a breadth of knowledge on kata and enabled me to realize that there is always more to learn and work on to be even more successful during the next competition.

From an athlete's standpoint, I understand all too well how much work, dedication and drive it takes to be successful in competition. For example, some junior athletes may have limited funds to send their children to train in clinics or competitions in other states, which is why travel costs should be factored into the selection of event locations.

Having been an athlete in soccer, swimming and international pistol (ISSF), I understand athletes need to have support from administrators, coaches and fellow athletes to be successful. In addition, I understand when conflicts arise, it is important to ensure integrity and fairness when addressing athletes' concerns. I have a background in higher education and was responsible for managing teams that submitted reports to federal and state agencies. It requires ethnics and integrity to ensure compliance with policies, procedures and regulations and a willingness to stand up when policies are not being followed.

USA Judo has great members and athletes in their organization. It is important to support them to keep the United States competitive in kata. It is important to recruit and train younger judoka for competition. This is the future of our sport in the United States, and I would love to be part of the success by serving on the kata committee as the athlete representative. I appreciate the time and effort in everyone who considers my candidacy to be the Athlete Representative on the Kata Committee.
