#### **US OPEN 2026**

Motion by Sandy Rios to move forward with Racquetball Revolution LLC as license holder for the US OPEN pending approval of a commonly agreed-upon contract.

U.S. Team Committee Recommendations (The World Games, August 2025) – Cheryl Kirk Supporting documents: IRF Letter dated 1/27/25 and U.S. Team Committee Minutes with Recommendation dated 2/5/25

Cheryl gave an overview and recap of the decision timeline to date.

Motion by Kristin Wattz to approve the U.S. Team Committee's recommendation as submitted to the USA Racquetball Board of Directors on February 10, 2025:

Based on information received from the IRF dated January 27<sup>th</sup>, the originally declared March 31<sup>st</sup> date will include, as required by the IRF, the submission of athlete names being the current 2024-2025 U.S. Team roster, also to include officials and delegates.

On or before May 25<sup>th</sup>, the Late Athlete Replacement Period deadline, two final athlete names (one male/one female) will be submitted. These names will be determined using USA Racquetball's selection processes, as stated in the U.S. Team Policies, Procedures, & Protocols Handbook (Section II – U.S. National Racquetball Team Event Selection) dated 6/1/25, that governs membership on the 2025-26 U.S. Team.

Athletes who qualify for the 2025-26 U.S. National Team at the National Indoor Championships Team Qualifier will not be considered for TWG 2025 until a fully executed U.S. Team Contract is on file with USA Racquetball.

#### **Seconded by Steve Czarnecki**

Discussion: An athlete asked for clarification on submitting two tentative names with the rest as a list of potential replacements. If two names need to be submitted by March 31, along with potential replacement athletes additionally submitted, the two should logically be the current team's national champions.

Vote: Passed (Sandy Rios, Jake Bredenbeck, Erika Manilla, and Janel Tisinger-Ledkins abstained from voting)

Motion by Karen Grisz that the Board agree with the committee's opinion that the selection criteria for TWG 2025 would give right of first refusal to the #1 Men's and #1 Women's singles champions at the National Indoor Championships in Pleasanton, California, May 14-18, 2025, and that they would be required to also play as mixed doubles partners.

## **Seconded by Glen Gitterman**

Discussion surrounding logistics of executing a tight turnaround between May 18 and the IWGA notification deadline; suggestion that the U.S. Team Committee remain involved with the selection process should either athlete decline; responsibility and timeline of the Committee and the Board to approve the final delegation; sending the Board-approved Handbook/Contract document ahead of time to athletes entering the Indoor National Championships Team Qualifier divisions) to ensure everyone has an opportunity to review content; having contracts on site for signatures; ensuring all passports are current.

### Vote: Passed (Jake Bredenbeck and Erika Manilla abstained from voting)

Next steps: Cheryl Kirk to contact U.S. Team Committee Chair Larry Haemmerle to inform him of the decisions above and to collaborate on an immediate communication with U.S. Team athletes.

#### **Handbook Review**

Cheryl Kirk to forward the 6/1/24 U.S. Team Policies, Procedures, & Protocols Handbook to the athlete representatives for their review and comments with a deadline of February 19. Input received will be consolidated into one document for the committee's consideration and the Board's ratification.
