

2023 USA Diving Winter Nationals Qualifier Criteria

Criteria for Qualifying to the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championships

November 28-30, 2023
Allan Jones Aquatic Center
Knoxville, TN

Just prior to the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championships, USA Diving will host the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championship Qualifier Event in Knoxville, TN to contest advancement to the Winter National Championships.

Please note: This Qualifier Event will serve as a preliminary part of the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championships, and is therefore a national team tryout competition meeting the criteria of NCAA bylaw [16.8.1.2 \(a\)](#).

Contested events

- a. Men's 1-meter, 3-meter, and 10-meter (ONE LIST ONLY)
- b. Women's 1-meter, 3-meter, and 10-meter (ONE LIST ONLY)

Advancing to the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championships from the Qualifier:

- a) All those seeking to achieve qualification status may participate in the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championship Qualifier. The individual events in this Qualifier event will serve as the only qualification method to the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championships. Any diver who achieves the qualifying score (Table 1 below) with the DD requirement (Table 2 below), may compete in the 2022 USA Diving Winter National Championships.

Registration for the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championship Qualifier:

All Athletes and Coaches must have Eligible USA Diving memberships, and they shall register for the event through [DiveMeets.com](https://www.usadiving.org/Events/Meetings/2023USAWinterNationalChampionshipQualifier). Late fees will go into effect at 5 p.m. Eastern on November 14th, 2023. Online registration will still be available after 5 p.m. Eastern on November 14th, 2023, with a \$100/diver late fee.

Athletes who qualify on to the 2023 USA Diving Winter National Championships will be able to register for the event with the late fee waived.

**Note: Every International Participant must be a member in good standing of their home federation and have permission from their federation to compete. A request from the federation must be submitted to Olivia Rosendahl (oliviari@usadiving.org) for approval. All requests received by 5 p.m. ET on November 23, 2022, will receive full consideration for approval; any requests received after the deadline will be subject to review at USA Diving's discretion. International divers will be eligible to receive a place finish and move on to Winter Nationals,*

but will not displace a U.S. diver from a qualification slot.

****Note: junior divers must perform all dives off 10-meter, but do not need to meet the DD requirements. No more than TWO voluntary dives may be included in the junior diver's list.**
