Competition Office / Bib Pick up / Team Captains meeting

Comp office is located on the second floor of the 10th Mountain Lodge. Bib pick up will be in Room 35 on the second floor of the wax building. Team Captain's meeting will be located on the main floor of the 10th Mountain Lodge and will also be on Zoom through a link to coaches' emails.

Awards

US Biathlon National Championship awards will be presented to the top 3 USA competitors in each category including USBA, IBU and IPC. Prize money for Senior Categories at Saturday and Sunday's races will be awarded to the top 3 per gender: \$750, \$500, \$250. We will present awards for the top 3 competitors for the overall in each class when there are foreign competitors in the top three overall.

US Biathlon and FKOC will be hosting the first **US Biathlon Collegiate National Championships** for the Sprint event. We will recognize the top three individual athletes with podium ceremonies in both genders, and top five for podium ceremony and photo opportunities. Wax Cabins

Wax Cabins are available to rent for \$75 per day, there are 14 available in the wax building on a first come reservation basis on the 20ne-4 registration page. If you missed reserving when you registered on 20ne-4, a reservation can be made with Pat Theriault at there is power, heat, ventilation, and chairs in each room, but you need to provide your table.

Wax Protocol

All IBU Classes will be subject to wax protocol, time and place to turn in your skis to wax techs will be provided at the Captains Meeting. All other classes will wax their own skis.

Lodging

There are many lodging options in the Fort Kent area, but no large hotels. We compete with the snow mobilers for rooms this time of year, so don't delay to make reservations early if you are thinking of coming to Fort Kent. We have set up a Housing office to help coordinate options for you. The University of Maine at Fort Kent is offering housing and meals. Travel

The closest airport to Fort Kent is in Presque Isle, Maine, one hour south of us. United Airlines has a direct flight from Newark, NJ into Presque Isle, and several rental car agencies operate out of there. Other airport options are Boston Mass (8 hrs away), Bangor ME (3 hrs), Portland ME (5 hrs), or Quebec City, Quebec (3 hrs plus border crossing). The best border to cross coming in from Canada is in Clair NB just across the border from Fort Kent... they know biathlon and are usually easier to get along with.







REGISTRATION

Registration and Fees

Registration is available online only via Zone 4 at fkocresults.com Payment must be made via credit card, registration will close March 17, 2024 at 17:00. Event registration will be \$40 per race plus \$35 for the banquet Saturday night. Wax rooms are \$75 per day. There will be a \$30 late registration fee for all registrants after March 4, 2024. Please register early to help us plan race starts and meals. All coaches must be Safe Sport compliant and register on Zone 4. This will ensure any Zoom links and updates will be received.

Non Resident Firearms Declaration

Competitors from outside the USA must have authorization to bring their rifles into the U.S. You must have an approved USATF Form 6 NIA prior to entry to the U.S. This can take any where from 6-8 weeks. This process requires an invitation for which you can use the cover letter of the document for. The link for the form is:

Cancellation policy

If the event is cancelled due to extreme weather conditions or due to participant health issues on or before March 17 a refund of 75% of the registration fee will be distributed. If any portion of the event is cancelled during the competition due to extreme weather, no refund of registrations fees will be processed.

Event Rules


The current IBU event and competition rules will be in effect for the event. Any modifications to the rules will be discussed at the Team Captains Meeting.
