AWARDS & BRACKETS

High School & Middle School: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place medals in each weight division. Novice /JV (white belt) will receive ribbons. Modified double elimination system will be used, three or fewer contestants will use a round robin system. If there is only one contestant in a division the contestant may compete in the next heaver division; otherwise, a competitor may only compete in qualified division (see Middle School exception below). Other modifications of the brackets may be necessary with the approval of coaches of the contestants involved. For the overall High School Championship, points will be awarded as follows. Varsity divisions: 1st - 10 points, 2nd - 7 points, 3rd - 5 points. JV divisions: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 1 point.

ELIGIBILITY

All competitors must be a current member and show their membership card from their national judo organization.

High School Event: All competitors must be: at least 15 years of age and no more than 19 years of age; in at least 9th grade enrolled full-time; in good standing in a High School in Idaho, Oregon, Washington; and may be of any rank. (Upon request of coach and parent/guardian, Tournament Director may waive age requirement.) Middle School event: All competitors must be: at least 12 years of age and no more than 15 years of age; in at least 7th grade enrolled full-time; in good standing in a Middle School or Junior High School in Idaho, Oregon, Washington, or British Columbia; and may be of any rank. Students at middle schools that include 6th grade may compete if they are at least 12 years of age or have their parent or guardian sign an additional waiver. Students in 9th grade may elect to compete in the High School Event and/or the Middle School Event. Students wishing to compete in two divisions must submit two entry forms and fees (a second waiver is not required). Middle School (9th grade) entrants will be fighting under Senior High School rules if they choose to compete in Senior High School divisions.

ENTRY FEE & ENTRY DEADLINE

OTHER INFORMATION

Current IJF Rules will apply with the following modifications: There will be no chokes or arm bars. Competition areas will have a 3-meter safety area. Blue judogi or IJF approved judogi will not be required. No drop knee or sacrifice throws allowed in JV/White Belt and Middle School divisions. Competitors who have registered on-line or through their club/school may submit completed entry forms, waivers and entry fees during the check-in time on the day of the tournament. Inquiries should be directed to a tournament director. Weigh-in will be conducted remotely by the team sensei May 6 to 9 and emailed to a tournament director. Senseis may challenge any weight, and that competitor's weight must be within 5% of their stated weight. If their weight is found to be out of compliance, the competitor may, with approval of a tournament director, pay a fee of \$20 and change divisions.
