• Starting and Maneuvering the Boat – check for people and obstructions in the					
water, proper start procedure with driver in operator's seat, etc.					
Communication with Skier – explain the intended boat path, determine if the					
skier is a beginner and if he knows the skier safety signals, etc.					
Pulling the Skier:					
Acceleration – proper throttle control for the ability/experience of the skier					
Steering – directional control while monitoring boat traffic, obstructions and communication with observer					
Stabilizing the Speed – ability to control speed during and after take-off					
Adjusting the Speed to Skier Request – ability to react to observer input and stabilize speed at a new level					
Return to Fallen Skier – proper use of "half-turn" or "key-hole" pattern passing
