

# LBC Leadership Meeting Minutes May 2, 2024

#### **Events**

- Junior Olympics/ Summer Festival June 22 29, 2024 Wichita, KS
  - Registration is open now through June 7,2024.
  - For boxers who need exemption, have them complete this link: https://forms.office.com/r/mvbVaushzh
  - o For LBCs with a local tournament, please send the list of local champions. We plan to send them invitations to register for the national JO tournament, at a discounted rate.
  - The JO parade will be on Sunday, June 23. For JO aged athletes (Bantam through Junior) looking to participate, they must check in on Saturday, June 22.
  - The medal ceremony will take place after finals on Saturday June 29th, to include bronze medals.
  - o Cost share invitations for officials are projected to go out a week from today, May 3, 2024.
- Women's Championship

## **Membership**

- Due to various events, membership has a high volume of documents to process. Please advise your members to contact membership to have those documents approved over the phone.
- Passbooks shall only be distributed by the LBC registration chair or their designee. Passbooks shall not be distributed to coaches/clubs to then distribute to their boxers.

## **Operations**

- Reminded LBCs that those in financial compliance are awarded a free sanction. The sanction application was sent via email with these minutes.
- Reiterated the requirements for all pro-am, 3<sup>rd</sup> party, and multi/day multi ring sanctions, to include what they involve, (pre and post event, i.e. financials statements, matchtracker, etc.).
- Questions were asked surrounding unsanctioned event participation. Explained to LBC the safety concerns with multisport participation and its lack of reporting. Expressed to LBC leaders to contact Andrew Banuet to assist the LBC with handling such matters, as they are reviewed case by case.

• A question was asked about hosting amateur events that featured more than one discipline (i.e. boxing and kickboxing). We advised to contact Andrew to assess. Generally, we would treat it similarly to a proam event, where there needs to be a <u>clear</u> distinction between both sports. However, USA Boxing would like to discuss the details with the host before any action is taken, to ensure a proper assessment.
