1. Call to Order

- Chair: Khoa Nguyen

Update to 2025 Athlete Code of Conduct:

- Based on the incident at the Youth World Championships and similar issues in other youth events, the HPC proposed adding a clause to the Athlete Code of Conduct.
- Proposed Amendment: Parents are prohibited from interfering with coaches' decisions during the international event. Coaches have the authority to send players home if they violate the code of conduct during an event, with any associated costs incurred by the player.

• Athlete Code of Conduct Amendment:

- o **Motion:** A motion was presented to approve the HPC's proposal to amend the Athlete Code of Conduct.
- o **Resolution:** The committee unanimously approved the motion regarding the new amendment to the Athlete Code of Conduct.
