Position Summary:

USA Team Handball is seeking committed and capable **Assistant Coaches** to support the Senior National Team Head Coaches in implementing competitive and developmental objectives. These positions will contribute directly to training, planning, talent identification, and continuity across the national team system.

In addition to supporting the Senior Team, Assistant Coaches may be called upon to contribute to the alignment and development of Junior, Youth, and Cadet programs, and to assist with talent development across U.S.-based and Europe-based athlete pools.

Assistant appointments will be made in cooperation between appointed Head Coaches and the CEO.

Key Responsibilities:

- Support training sessions, match preparation, and performance analysis for the Senior Team
- Assist with athlete evaluation, selection, and development
- Collaborate with junior and development-level coaches to ensure continuity across the pipeline
- Help track and support domestic and international athletes within the broader talent pool
- Contribute to planning of training camps, competitions, and technical meetings
- Foster a positive, accountable, and athlete-centered team culture

Preferred Qualifications:

- Coaching experience in elite club, international or national team settings
- Strong knowledge of modern handball systems, training methodologies, and longterm athlete development

- Ability to operate effectively in decentralized, travel-intensive environments
- Must be legally eligible/obtain authorization to travel to and work within the United States

Contract Terms:

This is a contract-based position. Compensation, where applicable, is defined in individual agreements. Reimbursement for approved travel and related expenses is provided. USA Team Handball is headquartered in Colorado; Applicants must be eligible to operate as independent contractors under applicable U.S. and Colorado law and must be able to obtain legal authorization to enter and work in the United States for the duration of any inperson assignments. Applicants do not need to possess such authorization at the time of application but must be eligible to acquire it, including any necessary visas or work permits.
