

## **NY WSO Board Meeting – Sunday, April 24<sup>th</sup>**

### **LWC/WSO Records**

- Jerry Dunne had asked ahead of this meeting if his State record (made at the recent Mintz Memorial Meet) counted as a WSO record or a LWC record.
- Joe Rodriguez requested to preserve LWC records and start creating new WSO records.
- Chris Smith requested to carry over LWC records to the WSO records. If Niagara has a record that needs to be added, we will accommodate that in the WSO records.
- James McDermott made a motion to carry over the LWC records (July 2018 and beyond, after the weight class changes) to the current WSO records, Chris Smith seconded the motion.
- *VOTE TO CARRY LWC RECORDS OVER TO BECOME WSO RECORDS*: all 6 attending members were in favor, vote was passed.
- Joe Rodriguez requested to make a public call for records from Niagara so that they may be added.

### **State Meet Records**

- A member had queried about the validity of the 2019 State Championship records in the eyes of the new WSO.
- Brief discussion ensued, touching upon what level of involvement Niagara/Buffalo had in planning 2019 State Championships since this meet was during the days of separate Metropolitan & Niagara LWCs.
- Sara Soto made a motion to keep the meet records from 2019 intact, John Fiorella seconded it.
- *VOTE TO CARRY OVER RECORDS FROM 2019 STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS TO CURRENT WSO STATE RECORDS*: James, Sara, John, Frank are in favor, Chris & Joe abstain. A majority passed this vote.
