## USSTTA Sandpaper Event :

The USSTTA Sandpaper Event will be held on Friday night, September 29, 2023 beginning at 6:00 p.m. Players should arrive and sign in from 5:30-6:00 p.m. All players will be divided into round robin groups, depending on the number of entries and the ratings of the players, using the "Snake System". The winner of each round robin group will advance to a single elimination final. Players without ratings will be given an estimated rating based on their club rating, if available. All matches will be best 2 out of 3 to 21 points. Sandpaper rules will apply. Long pants, long sleeve shirts, hats or caps are permissible. Nittaku ( $40+\mathrm{mm}$ Poly White) balls will be used. Trophies will be awarded to $1^{\text {st }}$ through $2^{\text {nd }}$ Place and $\$ 25$ to the winner.
