**Competition Rules and Format:** Modified IJF rules will be used. All divisions will be true double elimination. Light/Medium/Heavy weights (Madison Brackets) based on age/weight of entrants

### **Athlete Requirements:**

- Athletes must be currently registered and insured with USA Judo and present proof of membership upon registration.
- Athletes are required to present proof of age upon registration
- Athletes are required to complete the warning, waiver, release of liability, and agreement to participate upon registration

Tournament director will pair each athlete accordingly to ensure fair matches. In the event an athlete is uncontested and has no matches, the athlete may choose to receive their gold medal OR choose to be issued a refund.

**MAAPP POLICY:** The Center for SafeSport has developed the Minor Athlete Prevention Policies (MAAPP) which USA Judo has adapted to our own sport. The MAAPP is a collection of proactive and training policies comprised of two parts; Education and Training Policy that requires training for certain Adult Participants and the Required Prevention Policies, focused on limiting one-on-one interactions between Adult Participants and Minor Athletes to prevent abuse.
