This will be a 2-day event. (Friday, March 14th) Saturday Color Belt Sparring competitor weigh-ins (2pm-8pm): All Ages Weigh-ins Ages 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 32+ All belts sparring Day 1 (Saturday, March 15th) All Color Belt competitions All Poomsae competitions

Note: For Poomsae, all color belt and 6-11 year old Black Belt divisions have only two rounds, prelim and final. For any division with more than 9 competitors, the top 8 competitors will advance to the final round. For any division with less than 9 competitors, all competitors will advance straight to the final round. Competitors will perform one Poomsae for prelim and one Poomsae for the final round. **Designated Poomsae will be released closer to the tournament date.**

All the other black belt divisions (individual age 10+, pairs and teams) will do WT cut off format performing one Poomsae for prelim, one Poomsae for semi-final round and two Poomsae for the final round. **Designated Poomsae will be released closer to the tournament date.**

All Black Belts ages 10 and over will compete in the Individual Recognized Poomsae format. No exceptions.

All board breaking competitors must use boards provided by TXTKD and must be purchased at the time of Credential Pickup. Each board is \$3.00. Cash only please.

ALL COMPETITORS must check-in at registration for credential pick-up to be included in their division brackets. Saturday competitors must be checked in by 9:00am to be included in the brackets.

If you are competing in BOTH Day 1 and Day 2 events, you will pick up your credentials on Saturday morning and you MUST come back to weigh in on Saturday afternoon. Sparring competitors who do not weigh-in may be disqualified.

Weigh-in Rules

- ALL sparring competitors MUST weigh-in the DAY BEFORE the scheduled competition. A
 maximum of two (2) weigh-ins are allowed per athlete. The 2nd weigh-in must occur before
 registration is officially closed.
- Contestants are required to show a valid form of ID to weigh-in.
- Any irregular action by the competitor or coach during the weigh-in may result in disqualification from event participation.
- Weigh-ins, for both males and females, shall be done in athletic clothing. A total of .2 kgs will be deducted from the weight on the scale. Under NO circumstance may an athlete weigh-in in the nude in the U.S. No sports bras or crop tops. <u>All females and males must wear a T-shirt and Shorts.</u>

Coach Fees

Coaches must have current and up-to-date Safe Sport training and background check in order to participate in this event. All coaches must follow rules and regulations, keep in Martial Arts conduct, and abide by USATKD rules and regulations.

No onsite registration for athletes or coaches. This includes adding events. Any changes on site will have a minimum charge of \$50 cash paid on site.

Coach Requirements

In addition to the coach's attire and conduct requirements as outlined in USAT, there will be the following requirements:

- Coach courtesy hold and match management:
 - First-round we will make accommodations for coaches with multiple athletes in separate rings.
 - Due to the scale and scheduling of this event, referees will be instructed NOT to hold matches until Black Belt Finals
 - Once the division brackets and match orders are set by officials, no changes will be accepted on the floor.
- Coach etiquette:
 - No recording video or pictures ringside or on the competition floor.
 - o No phones, headsets, earbuds, etc. at ringside or on the competition floor.
 - No loitering behind the ring table.
 - No questions during the competition.

Violations of etiquette may be penalized with a yellow card (sanction).

Competitor Awards

Medals will be awarded to one 1st, one 2nd and two 3rd place winners.

Competition Area & Rules

Per USAT regulations, the competition area is open only to the following personnel. Everyone else must watch from the designated spectator areas.

- Registered & certified coaches
- Registered & certified referees
- Registered athletes
- Texas State Taekwondo Association staff & volunteers

Anyone on the competition floor must have Safe Sport Background Check membership.

Mandatory Competition Equipment

OFFICIAL POOMSAE UNIFORM (DOBOK)

- All contestants must wear a white Taekwondo V-neck PATU/WT approved uniform or WT approved Poomsae competition uniform in good condition, and appropriate to the contestants' division.
- Black Belts must wear black-collared white uniforms or WT approved Poomsae competition uniform.
- Only black belt athletes 14 and under may wear a poom belt. If an athlete wears a poom collar uniform they must wear a poom belt.
- Color belts may not wear black-collared uniforms.

OFFICIAL SPARRING UNIFORM (DOBOK)

- All contestants must wear a white Taekwondo V-neck PATU/WT uniform (dobok) in good condition
- Black belts must wear black-collared uniforms.
- Poom rank (14 and under black belts) may wear poom uniforms with black and red collars.
- Color belts must wear white-collared uniforms; color belts cannot wear black-collared uniforms.
- No tape will be allowed on any part of the uniform.





All sparring competitors must wear (USAT approved):

- White or red or blue headgear (red & blue headgear must be matched with chest protector color); Ages 12-32 World Class Black Belt Sparring competitors must have a Red or Blue headgear.
- Red and blue reversible chest protector (hogu)
- Forearm guards
- Shin and instep guards
- Groin cup (male AND females, All Ages)
- White or Transparent Mouthpiece. Competitors with braces need to cover both upper and lower teeth when braces are present on both.
- Ages 12-32 World Class and Grassroot Black Belt Sparring competitors must also wear WT approved TKD Gloves. NO iCross brand gloves permitted.

PSS Scoring requirements

KP&P PSS hogus and electronic head gear will be used for black belts ages 12-32.

We will use KP&P PSS. <u>Black Belt Athletes Ages 12-32 will need their own KP&P electronic socks.</u> Electronic Hogu/Helmets will be provided. These are sparring competitors in divisions using Senior Rules where head contact is allowed.

All Color belts and all belts 6-11 and 32+ will need to bring their own hogu and head gear. Esocks are not required.

Points Ranking System

TXTKD will use the current Tusah U.S. National Rankings to seed each division at the event. Seeding for events will be based off the current posted rankings on the USATKD website as of 7pm CST the Thursday prior to the tournament.





SPARRING INFORMATION

We will use USATKD up-to-date rules and regulations, Best 2 of 3 rounds will be criteria used for sparring. We will not use the Cadet Weight/Height delineations for Cadet divisions (only weight).

Modified Head Contact RULES

Attacks to the head with light contact are allowed. The Referee will penalize the athlete for excessive contact. No extra points for spinning head kicks.

Turning kick to the head is not considered as a valid turning kick in determining penalty for falling down and superiority (Articles 14.4.1.2 and 15.5 of the Kyorugi Competition Rules)

The referee can decide the winner of RSC (Referee Stop Contest) in case of a significant difference of competing ability between two athletes.

Consists of 1 competitor for the following age divisions: Youth (10-11), Cadet (12-14), Juniors (15-17), U30 (18-30), U40 (31-40), U50 (41-50), U60 (51-60), U65 (61-65) O65 (66+)

PAIRS POOMSAE (CO-ED)

Consists of 1 Male & 1 Female Black Belt competitors for the following age divisions: Youth (10-11), Cadet (12-14), Juniors (15-17), U30 Pairs (18-30), U50 Pairs (31-50) & U60 (51-60) Pairs O65 Pairs Poomsae.

TEAM POOMSAE

Consists of 3 competitors of the same gender for the following age divisions: Youth (10-11), Cadet (12-14), Junior (15-17), U30 Team (18-30), O30 Team (31-50) U50, U60, and +60 Team Poomsae.

REGISTRATION

Ensure competitors are registered for ALL events they plan on participating in by the time registration closes. NO ONSITE registrations will take place. Meaning, if you plan on competing in a Team or in Pairs, but one (1) member did not register, your team or pair will be disqualified. *2025 Texas State Taekwondo Championships will not have Dragon or Tiger Pairs or Team Poomsae, or Color belt Co-Ed Pairs or Team Poomsae.*

POOMSAE PRE-COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

Athletes competing in Recognized Poomsae Pairs, Recognized Poomsae Teams, Freestyle Pairs and Freestyle Teams have additional pre-competition requirements to ensure smooth competition. Pairs and Teams are required to report their team membership here (https://form.jotform.com/250355281614049).





DEMONSTRATION TEAM and BOARD BREAKING INFORMATION

DEMO TEAM COMPETITION GENERAL GUIDELINES

- The performance must be confined to the 12m x 12m Contest Area. 0.1 points shall be deducted from the final score each time a contestant crosses the boundary line during performance. Any performance outside of the boundary will not be considered.
- All contestants must wear appropriate sport attire, such as V-neck Taekwondo uniform of any color, Y-neck Poomsae competition uniform, or team track suit.
- The maximum set-up time is 1 minute.
- The maximum time to complete the performance is 6 minutes.
- The maximum clean-up time is 1 minute.
- The machine to play music shall be provided by the Tournament Committee.
- There will be NO standing on chairs or tables, and no use of tumbling boards or any similar devices.
- Use of poles and similar devices to hold boards for high jumping breaks are permitted; these must be approved in advance.
- Due to safety and liability issues, absolutely NO weapons, pyrotechnics, fireworks or flame breaks. - Boards must be purchased from designated vendor at the competition venue. Under no circumstances should athletes bring their own boards.
- No Head Stikes Allowed

The Texas State Taekwondo Championships will be using the following rule set for breaking. State Championship Breaking Rules are modified to make the tournament run in a professional & timely manner.

- Time: Maximum 2 minutes to setup and perform the breaking routine. All boards, broken boards and wood fragments must be cleaned up following routine.
- Not Allowed: Chairs, Trampolines, Tables, Spacers, Pencils, Bricks, Cinder Blocks, Fingers as Spacers, 1 Inch Boards, Demo Boards, Bending Boards, Tampering with Boards
- Number of Boards: Number of Boards: 15 Boards Maximum. Difficulty level is factored by the formula # boards multiplied by 0.2, which contributes to the Technical part of the score.
- Board Size: 12 inches by 8 inches and 3/8 inches thick (1/2 inch nominal) for ALL competitors.
 All boards MUST be purchased on site. Any tampering with boards will lead to immediate disqualification. Referees will be check occasionally.
- Board Holder: Coaches will be allowed to be on stage to hold boards. However, if you do not have a board holder, every ring will provide a board holder.
