This credential will get the athlete, referee or coach into the venue even on days they are not participating, they do not need a spectator ticket. Once you have picked up the credential, please confirm that the following information is correct Name, Age and Divisions. If any information is incorrect, please see the registration computers to get it corrected.

Explanation: Division will have the following letters plus numbers to show which event the athlete is competing in (example WB200)
