- 1. States P/L total revenue \$66,200.75, Total Expenses \$36,954.21
- 2. Total Profit \$29,246.54
- 3. Total Lifters 495
- 4. 3rd Platform was necessary for the number of lifters
- 5. Host and setup were excellent
- 6. Two incidents wrong barbell for a few lifters in a session on day one, and on day 3 there as a volunteer (with a history of seizures) had a seizure and was treated on scene and recovered. Parents arrived at venue to assist and he re-joined the competition later
- 7. International Athlete funding, records and FL Elite are continuing to be fully funded
- 8. For 2025 Florida Elite, all invitations are out, and team rosters are being finalized.
- 9. Only top 5 athletes on a team's roster are scored this year at nationals

New Business

- 1. Standards for making international teams are harder, so we expect the total cost of international team funding to decrease as fewer Florida athletes may make teams.
- 2. Christina Drown of USA Weightlifting was praised for her rapid communication and payment of invoices
- 3. Florida WSO Board member elections will be opened this September for 2026-2030 term, with voting in November 2025
- 4. We expect to open the bid process and receive bids for 2026 State Championships shortly after national championship week.
