FACILITY AND EQUIPMENT

Pool Equipment: Two 1-meter & Two 3-meter boards. 3m, 5, 7.5m, and 10m platforms.

Hot tub will be available for competitors located behind the 1-meter boards.

Sparger will be available on Thursday, May 1st from 4-6pm only. Only approved personnel may operate bubbles, please contact <u>divemeetmgt@gmail.com</u> if your team is interested in use of the sparger. Instructions on use and approved personnel will be given via email.

Dryland Equipment: Mats will be available for stretching in the mezzanine. Trampoline and dry boards will not be available for use by competitors.

REGISTRATION

All participants must be "Current" members of USA Diving. All athlete and coach entries must be made online at www.divemeets.com prior to April 17 5:00 pm EST. No athlete or coach will be permitted access to the pool deck without having completed their DiveMeets registration. Athletes may still register after the deadline up until 3 hours prior to their event with an added late fee of \$100. If a coach misses the online registration deadline, a \$20 late fee will be assessed prior to deck authorization.

The entry fees for all 2025 Regional Championships total \$85.00 per event. For more information about how these fees are broken down and how they are used, please CLICK HERE to visit the USA Diving Website where more information can be found.

DIVE CHANGES

All dive changes, including payment, MUST be done online through DiveMeets. Athletes may log into their DiveMeets account to review and update their dive sheets within the timeline outlined below:

- 1. Changes may be made online at no cost before 6pm the night prior to the first day's events, and before 12pm the day prior to all competition days thereafter.
- 2. After the designated times in point 1, athletes may make changes to their dive sheets online at a cost of \$15 per event up until 3 hours prior to their event start time.
- 3. Dive changes will no longer be accepted three hours prior to the corresponding event.







PARTICIPANT COMPORTMENT

USA Diving promotes good sportsmanship from athletes, coaches and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racist or sexist comments, or other intimidating actions directed at judges, meet personnel, athletes, coaches, spectators, or team representatives are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing or bullying, and acts of cyberbullying by members towards any member is strictly prohibited. Retaliation against any person who reports, is thought to have reported, files a complaint or otherwise participates in an investigation or inquiry is also strictly prohibited. False charges shall also be regarded as a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action or other appropriate sanctions. Persons whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. USA Diving may also make referrals to law enforcement officials.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.

CHECK-IN TABLE

A check-in table for athletes and coaches will be located in the lobby beginning May 1st at 3:30pm. Please stop at the check-in table for credentials. Athletes and coaches without credentials will not be permitted on the pool deck.

A check-in table for spectators will be located in the lobby beginning May 3rd at 7:30am. Please stop at the check-in table to purchase your wristband for the session or weekend. Only cash, Venmo, and PayPal will be accepted at the check-in table.

*Please note times could change based on final event schedule.

RESTROOMS

Athletes: Only the use of locker rooms adjacent to the pool will be available for athletes. Locker rooms are equipped with private stalls. Changing outside of private stalls by participants is prohibited.

Coaches/Staff/Adults: Only the use of mezzanine restrooms is permitted.

Spectators: Only use of mezzanine restrooms is permitted.

FIRST AID/MEDICAL SERVICES

Lifeguards will be onsite at the competition venue during training and competition to provide first aid. They are responsible for responding to all emergencies in the water. They will initiate the EMS services procedures in place by the aquatic center when needed. In case of an emergency, the EMS will decide which hospital the patient will be transferred to depending on the type of injury.

ATHLETIC TRAINING/PHYSIOTHERAPY

If your team is bringing any medical personnel, you must email michael.retcher@usadiving.org before the registration late fees take effect for them to be permitted on deck.

Use of the training room is permitted only with the use of a certified trainer.

A certified trainer may be available during the events. More information will be released at the technical meeting.

Icebags will be available to participants; however, only coaches are permitted to get ice.







COACH HOSPITALITY

Coach hospitality will be located inside a classroom off the lobby. Only credentialed personnel will be permitted to use hospitality.

Thursday evening will be open 4p-8p with soft drinks and light snacks provided.

Friday will have a light breakfast served when pool doors open with coffee and bagels. A full breakfast option will be available at 8:15a-10a. Dinner will also be available from 4p-6p.
