PRELIMINARY NOTICE TO THE ATHLETE SELECTION PROCEDURES

2028 Olympic Games

June 12, 2026

To provide information in a timely manner, USA Diving is releasing this Preliminary Notice to the Athlete Selection Procedures for the 2028 Olympic Games (Games). This document is being written as a complement, and not a substitute to the 2028 Olympic Games Athlete Selection Procedures. Additional communication will be released by USA Diving once the Athlete Selection Procedures have been approved by the USOPC.

A. Anticipated Athlete Eligibility Criteria:

- Athletes must comply with all World Aquatics (AQUA) eligibility requirements posted [here](#) (see Qualification).
- Athletes must be a national of the United States and hold a valid U.S. passport that will not expire for six months after the conclusion of the Games.
- Athletes must adhere to all USA Diving, USOPC, USADA, WADA, AQUA and International Olympic Committee (IOC) anti-doping protocols, policies, and procedures including participation in Out-of-Competition Testing, if applicable.
- Athletes must comply with the [USOPC Background Check Policy](#) and [USOPC Athlete Safety Policy](#).

B. AQUA Qualification System Overview:

- The maximum Team size can be sixteen (eight men and eight women); however final Team size will depend on earned AQUA quotas. AQUA quotas are awarded by quota places to National Olympic Committee (NOC).

- As the host country, the United States is guaranteed a quota place for each of the four synchronized diving events.
- The following competitions have been designated as opportunities for the United States to earn quota places in individual events:
 - Phase One: 2027 World Aquatics Championships
 - Phase Two: 2027 Pan American Games
 - Phase Three: 2028 World Aquatics Diving World Cup Stops One and Two

C. Anticipated Evaluation Events:

It is intended that athletes being considered for nomination to the 2028 Olympic Games will be evaluated on their performance at the 2028 U.S. Olympic Team Trials - Diving.

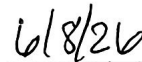
Delegation of Selection Procedure Authority
