<u>VENUE</u>



FACILITY AND EQUIPMENT

Pool Equipment:

Full Towers, two competition 3-meter boards, two competition 1-meter boards, at least one auxiliary 3-meter boards, and at least one auxiliary 1-meter boards.

Dryland Equipment:

Two 1-meter dry boards, two trampolines, full bounce floor and stretching area.

REGISTRATION

All participants must be "Current" members of USA Diving. All athlete and coach entries must be made online at <u>www.divemeets.com</u> prior to 5:00 pm EDT on April 22, 2024. No athlete or coach will be permitted access to the pool deck without having completed their DiveMeets registration. Athletes may still register after the deadline until 9:00 am on May 3rd with an added late fee of \$100.00. If a coach misses the online registration deadline, a \$100.00 late fee will be assessed prior to deck authorization.

The event entry fees for this event are \$50.00 plus a \$20.00 insurance fee per athlete per event (total \$70.00 per event).

DIVE CHANGES

All dive changes, including payment, MUST be done online through DiveMeets. Athletes may log into their DiveMeets account to review and update their dive sheets within the timeline outlined below:

- Changes may be made online at no cost before 6:00 pm on May 3rd for events competed on May 4th. Changes may be made online at no cost before 12:00 pm for events competed on May 5th.
- 2. After the designated times in point 1, athletes may make changes to their dive sheets online at a cost of \$15.00 per event until 3 hours prior to their event start time.
- 3. Dive changes will no longer be accepted after three hours prior to the corresponding event.

PARTICIPANT COMPORTMENT

USA Diving promotes good sportsmanship from athletes, coaches, and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racist comments, sexist comments, or other intimidating actions directed at judges, meet personnel, athletes, coaches, spectators, or team representatives are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Thank you in advance for your cooperation. Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing behavior, bullying, and acts of cyberbullying by members towards any member is strictly prohibited. Retaliation against any person who reports, is thought to have reported, files a complaint, or otherwise participates in an investigation or inquiry is also strictly prohibited. False charges shall also be regarded as a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action or other appropriate sanctions. Persons whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. USA Diving may also make referrals to law enforcement officials.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.

TECHNICAL MEETING

There will be a technical meeting conducted in person and via zoom at 8:00 pm on May 3rd, 2024. It is requested that at least one coach from every team attend in person at Allan Jones Intercollegiate Aquatics Center. Zoom link will be provided on or before May 3rd to coaches registered prior to the registration deadline.

ORDER OF EVENTS

A daily order of events is posted on the USA Diving website. A timeline will be released once the late fee for entries takes effect.

JUDGING

Each Region will be attended by one AQUA-Certified USA Diving Judge to serve as a Head Referee of the event.

CHECK-IN TABLE

Check-in table will be located near the front entrance on the spectator level.

RESTROOMS

Men's and women's athlete locker rooms will be located on the scoreboard end of the competition level.

Coach / Staff / Adult Participant restrooms will be located near the diving well and in the upstairs timing booth.

Spectator restrooms will be located on the scoreboard end of the spectator level.

FIRST AID/MEDICAL SERVICES

First aid may be provided by the facilities' lifeguard staff. AED devices are located around the facility.

COACH HOSPITALITY

Coach hospitality will be provided for breakfast and lunch on competition days only.

EVENT MERCHANDISE

Custom, event-branded apparel will be available on-site, provided by USA Diving's merchandise partner, Fine Designs. Get your 2024 USA Diving Regional Championships gear at their stand throughout the event!

PARKING

Parking will be free. Parking will be located at the Kingston Pike Lot, 2309 Kingston Pike, next to Tyson Park. You may also meter park on Lake Avenue, but you must pay the meter at those spots. If you choose not to park in the designated areas you are parking at your own risk and could be subjected to being towed, ticketed, or having your car booted.

FOOD/CONCESSIONS
