### Welcome from Mike McAtee, Executive Director

- Happy New Year! Thank you to LBC leaders for all your hard work.
- Excited that there are 32 LBC leaders on the call. Great turnout!
- Membership is about 1,500 higher than it was in November-December 2019.
- Hoping to go back to hosting regional calls.

### Oxygen Tanks

- USA Boxing will be purchasing and sending out portable Oxygen tanks to each LBCs and they MUST be at every event.
- LBCs that require ambulances will not receive them.
- Requirement for Spineboards was removed from the rulebook but oxygen is vital per our Medical Advisory Board.
- LBCs can purchase additional oxygen tanks for about \$350 each.

### Proper Sanctioning

- Ethan is putting out information on how to properly classify 3<sup>rd</sup> Party, Charitable and Fundraising events.
- It's vital that they are classified properly.
- We support other organizations, but USA Boxing boxers are our mission as a non-profit organization.
- If you are not sure, ask Ethan.

## Lynette Smith, Membership Director

- Thank you for the LBC D&O (Directors & Officers) insurance applications – this protects LBC leaders from personal liability relating to LBC matters.
- Our insurance broker has arranged for our non-profit clubs to purchase D&O coverage as well as small business insurance coverage protection.
- Membership is at 14,000 (Between Monday and Thursday 1739 have renewed or joined)

## Mike Campbell, Events & Boxing Operations Manager

- Re-stated the importance of classifying Pro-Am and 3<sup>rd</sup> party sanctions.
- Stressed the importance that boxers' bouts are entered into MatchTracker.
- National Championship Recap - biggest event with over 1,100 boxers competing.
- National Qualifier will be last week of April in Cleveland, which will be a qualifier for Nationals; the Summer Festival will be another qualifier.
- JOs, which will take place in July, will be an open tournament but LBCs may still hold LBC and regional events.

## Background Screening

- Remember that background screenings take time so encourage coaches to register early: Let membership know if you need help.

## State Athletic Commissions

- If you have an unsanctioned event, please let us and your state athletic commission know.

## Unsanctioned Events

- Disciplinary actions are given to all participating in unsanctioned events.
- USA Boxing non-athletes can participate in State sanctioned events but boxers cannot participate. Boxers can ONLY participate in USA Boxing sanctioned events.
- Reach out to Ethan as you hear of unsanctioned events.
