



TWO players or teams advance from each round robin group. Matches are best of 5, 11-point games. "T"=Trophy. Limit of 2 singles events per day per player.

Event Eligibility Ratings as of April 1 will be used for eligibility; April 6 for seeding. Unrated players may not advance from the round robin in rating-limited events, and may not enter doubles. Where adequate supporting evidence exists, tournament director may assign ratings for unrated players, who are then eligible to advance to the playoffs and enter doubles. Email, call, or text us per the “Information” paragraph below if you can’t find your last rating. Rated players with outdated or clearly inaccurate ratings may be re-rated. Events with insufficient entries may be cancelled and fees refunded.

Rules & Equipment You must be a member of USATT or ITTF to enter. Adult basic membership is \$25/year, or \$75 for Pro level. Please pay for your membership with your entry payment. All USATT-approved equipment: 12 Butterfly Nippon tables, Nittaku 3-Star Premium 40+ white balls. USATT rules including dress code will be enforced, clothing must not be white or near-white. Tournament Director and CR Sam Steiner. Wooden gym floor with bright 400 lux LED lighting. Showers & locker rooms available.

Directions Boys & Girls Club of Erie, 1515 East Lake Road, Erie, Pennsylvania, 16511, back entrance. Coming from the West or South, take I-90 or I-79, then I-79 north to the Bayfront Parkway. Follow the Parkway about 5 miles, turning right at the Port Access Road where indicated. Go another 1/2 mile on the Parkway and turn left at the first light onto East 6th St. Take 6th St. about 1 mile, it turns into East Lake Road at East Ave. Stay in the right lane as you approach East Ave, but don’t exit to the right. Go another 1/2 mile to the Boys & Girls Club at the Gilson Ave. light. Turn right on Gilson and go to the back parking lot. Coming from the East, exit I-90 at Route 430 North/Bayfront Connector. Take the Bayfront Connector 6.5 miles north and turn right onto East 6th St, then go one mile to the site as per above instructions. Please note that pizza will be the only food available on-site or in the immediate area. Please arrive at least 1/2 hour before your starting time.

Hotels Cobblestone Hotel offers reduced rates to tournament entrants on a first-come, first-served basis. Two locations, one located near I-90 and one near the downtown, both about equidistant from the tournament site. Mention Rate Code TABLET to receive reduced rates. Safesport Compliance

I understand USATT’s Safe Sport Policy including the organization’s Coaching Policy, which requires that all persons who are engaged in coaching activities at USATT Affiliated Member Clubs and/or USATT sanctioned tournaments, except parents or legal guardians coaching their own children, must be fully SafeSport compliant, which includes completing SafeSport training offered by the U.S. Center for SafeSport every year, and undergoing a criminal background screen every two years.
