AMENDMENT #1 TO 2025 FUNDING SCHEDULE High Performance Support

Reference is made to the Funding Schedule for High Performance Support, dated January 1, 2025 (the "Agreement") by and between the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC) and USA Taekwondo Inc.

WHEREAS, the USOPC and USA Taekwondo Inc entered into the Agreement.

WHEREAS, the USOPC and **USA Taekwondo Inc** now wish to amend the Agreement effective as of June 5, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and conditions hereinafter set forth, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows.

1. Amendment(s):

I. The parties hereby agree to amend the monthly stipends included in Exhibit A "Athlete Stipend Criteria" as follows. For purposes of clarity, sections of Exhibit A not included below remain unchanged.

Exhibit A Athlete Stipend Criteria

Olympic:

Elite Tier Monthly Stipends:

Eligibility to receive USATKD Elite Tier Monthly Stipends is based on achieving one of the following benchmarks:

Olympic Gold Medalist	\$3,500/month
Olympic Silver Medalist or World Championship Gold Medalist	\$3,000/month
Olympic Bronze Medalist	\$2,500/month

NOTE: Funding will begin the same month as the stipend-earning performance and will qualify the athlete for twelve (12) months of funding.

Tier 1 Monthly Stipends:

Eligibility to receive USATKD Tier 1 Monthly Stipends is based on achieving one of the following benchmarks:

World Championships Silver or Bronze Medalist	\$2,500/month
World Taekwondo (WT) Grand Prix Gold Medalist	\$2,500/month
Two or more WT Grand Prix Medals in a calendar year (for	\$2,500/month
example, 2 or more medals between Jan Dec of 2025).	

NOTE: Funding will begin the same month as the stipend-earning performance and will qualify the athlete for twelve (12) months of funding.

Tier 2 Monthly Stipends

Eligibility to receive USATKD Tier 2 Monthly Stipends is based on achieving one of the following benchmarks:

WT Grand Prix Silver or Bronze Medalist	\$1,750/month
Two or more WT G6 or higher quarterfinal finishes in a calendar-	\$1,750/month
year	
2024 Olympic Participant	\$2,000/month

Tier 3 Monthly Stipends

Eligibility to receive USATKD Tier 3 Monthly Stipends is based on achieving the following benchmarks:

2024 Pan American Championships Gold Medalist \$500/month

NOTE: Funding will begin the same month as the stipend-earning performance and will qualify the athlete for twelve (12) months of funding.

Tier 4 Monthly Stipends

Eligibility to receive USATKD Tier 4 Monthly Stipends is based on achieving the following benchmarks:

2025 Senior National Team Member	\$850/month
2025 WT Under 21 World Championship Gold Medalist	\$1,750/month
2025 WT Under 21 World Championships Silver or Bronze Medalist	\$1,500/month
Two or more WT Grand Prix Challenge Gold Medals in 2025	\$1,500/month

NOTE: 2025 Senior National Team member that will participate in the 2025 World Taekwondo Championships in Wuxi, China will qualify for a six (6) month stipend, July – December, 2025. Athletes that do not make weight at the World Taekwondo Championships will not receive a stipend in November or December.

The 2025 Under 21 World Championships medalist funding will begin the same month as the stipend-earning performance and will qualify the athlete for six (6) months of funding.

Funding for two or more gold medals at the WT Grand Prix Challenge in 2025 will begin the same month as the stipend-earning performance and will qualify the athlete for twelve (12) months of funding.

Paralympic:

Elite Tier Monthly Stipends:

Eligibility to receive USATKD Elite Tier Monthly Stipend is based on achieving a World Taekwondo ranking of 1-5.

II. The Parties hereby agree to amend the Olympic EAHI Criteria included in Exhibit B as follows:

Exhibit B

EAHI Criteria

Olympic:

Any athlete who qualifies for Athlete Stipends via Elite, Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 criteria as of January 1, 2025 will be offered EAHI. Athletes will be eligible for EAHI in the same month as their qualifying performance. If at any point an athlete no longer qualifies for Tiers 1-3 Athlete Stipends or EAHI-only criteria, they will be removed from EAHI, effective immediately.

- 2. <u>Effect of Amendment</u>. Except as provided to the contrary herein, all applicable terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. <u>Conflict of Provisions</u>. In the event of an inconsistency between this Amendment and the Agreement, this Amendment shall prevail.
- 4. Capitalized terms used herein without definition shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in the Agreement.
