- Confirmed our desire to host a WSO champs regardless of the fact we received no bids.
 We understand we may have to make it smaller as venue and size appears to be the biggest obstacle for Washington clubs/meet directors.
- Tacoma Strength and Paramount continue to evaluate whether they can host the championships due to venue limitations. Although Paramount Strength and Conditioning has expressed interest in hosting a smaller event for 2023, they are still negotiating for a nearby venue space.
- Qualifying totals, athlete limits and registration details to follow once venue and meet director are confirmed. Consensus is likely to be athletes capped closer to 150 than 250 IF we run one platform over two days and 5 sessions per day.
- o Volunteers will be needed for staffing, load in and out of venue, and technical officials.
