- X. 12/2023 Kata Committee meeting Decided on: Selection moving forward for IJF and PJC Judges. yellow highlight approved, with some level of hierarchy
  - a) For IJF: must have judged at <u>PJC championship</u> within last three years (or at least volunteered to go).
  - b) For PJC: judge at Nationals within last two years
  - c) Judge selection from previous year(s) allow for rotation / opportunities.
  - d) Active kata service (judge, administrative...)
    - Active in USA kata community: in committees, judge, clinician, coach, monthly kata discussions, instructor, team manager, "advanced student" (e.g., attending seminars with internationally credentialed clinicians)"
    - b. Active in practice with IJF criteria for judging: as judge (national and international), clinician, coach, monthly kata discussions, instructor, volunteer positions at IJF Worlds or PJC
    - c. Quality/level as judge, athlete, other (level and recency)
  - e) Rank only if all other things are equal (12/30)
