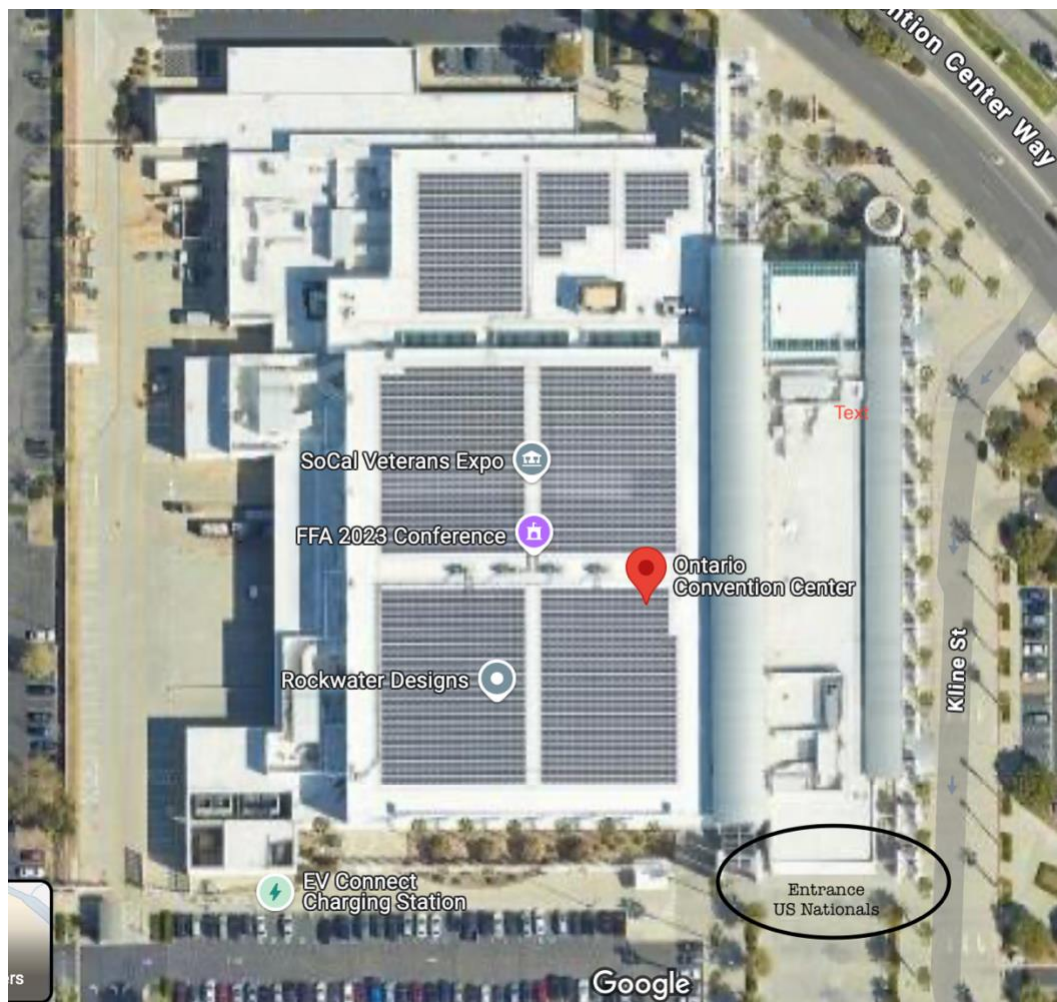

Floor: **Rubber Flooring on top of Concrete**

Playing system

- In Men's Singles (top 32) and Women's Singles, Women's U21 and Men's U21 Singles (top 16) players will be seeded out based on
 - 1. Top 100 in ITTF World Ranking List at the time of draw
 - 2. USATT Rating List

Mandatory Match Check-In: For Round Robin match play, players must register with the Control desk at least 30 minutes before their group is scheduled to start playing. Immediately after registering with the Control Desk, the player must go to his or her assigned table and be prepared to begin play. Even if you are not the first match, you must be ready to play ten minutes before the scheduled match. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in default. For Single Elimination matches, players must register with the Control desk at least 30 minutes before their assigned match start time. Immediately after registering with the Control Desk, the player must then go to his or her assigned table and be prepared to begin play. The only exception is documented conflict resolution sheet prepared in advance by the Conflict Resolution Station (CRS) at the Control Desk.

Event Scheduling: Events are not guaranteed to be completed on the same day that they begin. No refunds will be given for early departure. Each event will begin on the date/time designated on the form, and it will continue at regular intervals until a champion has been determined. An entrant's signature on the tournament entry form acknowledges that the dates are



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acceptable for participation in the registered events regardless of any holidays, federal, state, local, religious, or foreign. All events will be completed by July 4, 2025. Any event may be cancelled if the event contains less than four players or pairs, as appropriate. (For Event Fee Participants, the cost of an event cancelled for lack of appropriate numbers of participants will be refunded.)

Draws

- The following events will follow a pure snake draw with no separation: **U19, U17, U15, U13, and U11 Boys' and Girls' Singles.**
- All other events will implement **standard separation by state** during the group stage.

Accreditation

All coaches need to be fully SafeSport Compliant. Coaching Credential can be obtained at reception. For those with coaching license the entry at the event is free. All others need to purchase entry pass to the event for each day they are coaching

Live Draw for the seeded players in Men's Singles and Women's Singles will be conducted

Practice Time

- June 28: Opening hours: 8:00am to 2:00pm

Registration

- Registration will open on June 27 between 5pm and 8pm
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Check-in Time

- All Players must check in at least 20 minutes minutes before their match.

Field of Play

- During matches, up to 1 coach may sit at the bench – this coach must be accredited.
- All players and coaches must clear the field of play after their matches.



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- The venue will be open one hour prior to the first scheduled match.
- **Rules:** The 2025 US Nationals Table Tennis Championship matches will be conducted under the ITTF Laws of Table Tennis. Rules of match play are determined by the Referee. All matters, issues, guidelines, and ancillary decisions beyond match play related to sponsors and tournament venue decoration will be determined by the Tournament Management Committee in accordance with USATT Policies and Procedures, including the USATT Member Code of Conduct

Scheduling Conflicts: All Participants must report match conflicts at least 30 minutes prior to the conflict scheduled time. Participants are responsible for notifying the Control Desk. A conflict occurs when a players have matches in different events scheduled at the same time. Conflicts will be resolved by the Conflict Resolution Station at the Control Desk, where a person will dictate which match will be played in order and which match will occur later. Players must follow the direction of the USATT tournament committee's decision regarding the sequence of play in the resolution of Conflicts. Please note that your timely check-in helps us to keep the tournament running as scheduled. The earlier that you report a conflict of which you are aware, the more likely the Tournament will run on time. Timely check-in and conflict filing allows that some matches may be played EARLY to avoid the delays that arise with unavoidable conflicts.



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Coaching Requirements for the 2025 US National Table Tennis Championships

To be eligible to coach at the 2025 US National Table Tennis Championships, all coaches **must** meet the following requirements:

Mandatory Requirements:

- **SafeSport Certification:** Coaches must be SafeSport compliant.
- **Background Check:** A valid and completed background check is required.

⚠ **Important:** Any individual who is **not SafeSport compliant** will **not** be permitted to coach at the Nationals — **no exceptions**.

Coaching Accreditation Fees:

- **Free Coaching Accreditation:**
Coaches who meet **all** of the following criteria are eligible for **free accreditation**:
 - SafeSport Compliant
 - Background Check Completed
 - Hold a valid **USATT Coaching License**
 - Completed **ITTF or USATT Coach Education Program**

Coaches who are **SafeSport compliant** and have passed a background check but **do not hold a valid USATT Coaching License** will be required to pay a **Tournament Spectator Entry Pass**
