USA Karate Regional Referee Course Registration Procedure

To register for an official referee course, all instructors must use Tournament In a Box at <u>www.tournamentinabox.com</u>.

A non-instructor, USA Karate member, may host an official course. They may invite a certified instructor from the same region as the location of the course, or a Referee Committee (RC) member to conduct a course. However, they must still register for the seminar and pay the appropriate fee through Tournament In a Box. The RC members are exempt from regional restrictions.

- 1. All seminars are subject to a \$200.00 sanction fee per seminar.
- 2. All candidates for kata or kumite certification must register through Tournament In a Box or may register on-site. If registration is on-site, the instructor is responsible for ensuring that the candidate meets all membership requirements, including SafeSport, background check, test scores, etc
- 3. The candidate fee associated with the course can be paid through Tournament In a Box upon registration or directly to the host.
- 4. There are no registration requirements to audit the course.
- 5. Recommended fee for kata or kumite seminar is:
 - a. Audit fee: \$35.00.
 - b. Certification/license: \$55.00 per license
- 6. Any remaining fees above the sanction fee will be collected from the Tournament In a Box upon the conclusion of the referee course.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the host to issue a refund, if any, if someone pays for the course, registers but does not attend.

Recommendation fee to invite RC member as seminar instructor or chief referee:

- \$500.00 for seminar
- \$500.00 for competition

Recommendation fee for passports or badges:

The first badge: free. Afterwords or extra: \$5.00 USA Karate passport: \$15.00. Certificates: \$5.00
