National Team Trainer

Reports to:	National Coach in the Region
Selected by:	National Coach in the Region with Director of Sport Concurrence
Term:	Two years, option to renew, subject to annual review process
Direct reports:	None

• Responsibilities

- Responsible for working with the National Coach to improve US Team athletes in the assigned region.
- Responsible for assisting the National Coach in communication, planning and training of US Team athletes in the assigned region.

• Duties

- Lead, organize or assist in US Team training sessions as directed by the Lead National Coach of Region or Director of Sport.
- o Create, develop, and teach skill-development drills for US Team athletes.
- Assist the National Coach(es) in the region with communication, planning and training for the US Team athletes in the region.
- Attend all National Coaching Staff meetings, trainings, and US Team camps as directed by the Director of Sport.
- Be fully informed of all rules for competition, including when changes are made and published
- o All other duties assigned by the Director of Sport or National Coach in the region.

• Requirements

- o Training at least 1 member of the US Jr. or Sr. National Team Pool (preferred)
- Must have attended the USA National Championships and the US Jr. Team Trails in the previous year
- Must be a member of USA NKF in good standing, including Safe Sport and background check, PCA certification, USA NKF Dan certification, CPR/First Aid, USA Karate Judge A
- Preferably participated in a WKF level event as a personal coach within the previous two years
- \circ $\$ Have a good working relationship with the National Coach(es) in the region
- \circ Have a good working relationship with the US Team athletes in the region
- Have a good working relationship with the personal coaches of the US Team athletes in the region.

Selection Process

- o Submit letter of interest and resume to Director of Sport
- Interview with the Lead National Coach in the region
- Concurrence with the Director of Sport upon recommendation from the Lead National Coach in the Region
