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FACILITY AND EQUIPMENT

The James E. Martin Aquatics Center, opened in 1993, is the home to the Auburn Swimming and Diving team. The Martin Aquatic Center is designed as one of the premier natatoriums in the nation and provides its athletes with the perfect facility for training and competition. The facility is located at 664 Biggio Drive, Auburn, Alabama, 36830. The diving facility is 16.5 feet deep and features two 1-meter springboards, two 3-meter springboards, as well as 1, 3, 5, 7.5, and 10-meter platforms. The floor of the diving well is navy blue and provides a darker contrast which makes it easier for divers to spot the water during the course of a dive. The athletic training room is located in the back left corner of the facility, closest to the diving well.

The dryland equipment will be located in the building adjacent to the Aquatic Center, on courts three and four. This space will be equipped with a dry diving board, two trampolines, and stretching mats to support athlete training and preparation outside the pool.

REGISTRATION

All participants must be “Current” members of USA Diving. All athlete and coach entries must be made online at www.divemeets.com prior to April 28 5:00 pm EST. No athlete or coach will be permitted access to the pool deck without having completed their DiveMeets registration. Athletes may still register after the deadline up until three hours prior to their event with an added late fee of \$100. If a coach misses the online registration deadline, a \$20 late fee will be assessed prior to deck authorization.

The entry fees for the 2025 National Championships total \$115.00 per event.

DIVE CHANGES

All dive changes, including payment, MUST be made online through DiveMeets. Athletes may log into their DiveMeets account to review and update their dive sheets within the timeline outlined below:

1. Changes may be made online at no cost before 6:00 PM the night prior to the first day's events, and before 12:00 PM the day prior to all competition days thereafter.
2. After the designated times in point 1, athletes may make changes to their dive sheets online at a cost of \$15.00 per event up until three hours prior to their event start time.
3. Dive changes will no longer be accepted three hours prior to the corresponding event.



PARTICIPANT COMPORTEMNT

USA Diving promotes good sportsmanship from athletes, coaches and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racist or sexist comments, or other intimidating actions directed at judges, meet personnel, athletes, coaches, spectators, or team representatives are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing or bullying, and acts of cyberbullying by members towards any member is strictly prohibited. Retaliation against any person who reports, is thought to have reported, files a complaint or otherwise participates in an investigation or inquiry is also strictly prohibited. False charges shall also be regarded as a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action or other appropriate sanctions. Persons whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. USA Diving may also make referrals to law enforcement officials.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.

JUDGING

The 2025 USA Diving National Championships will follow a neutral seven-judge panel for all individual events and a neutral eleven-judge panel for all synchro events.

CHECK-IN TABLE

The check-in table will be located in the main lobby of the Aquatic Center, just inside the front entrance; credentials can be picked up at this location. Credentials will be issued to all athletes, coaches, athletic trainers and other staff that have registered online with Divemeets. Credentials will gain staff and participants access to areas closed to spectators, such as the pool deck. Credentials must be worn at all times while on-site. There will be a volunteer stationed there throughout the duration of the championship.

RESTROOMS

Coaches, judges, and staff restrooms will be located in the Student Activities Center adjacent to the Aquatic Center. Coaches, judges, and staff are also welcome to use the public spectator restrooms on the second floor directly to the right of the east side spectator entrance. Participant locker rooms and restrooms are located off the main lobby of the Aquatic Center.

FIRST AID/MEDICAL SERVICES

Personnel

Certified athletic trainer, provided by USA Diving, will be on site for practices and competitions. EMS on site for competitions.

AEDs are located in the On Deck AED Box on the East Side of the pool by the Lifeguard Room and the Athletic Training Room by Diving Well. 17 Vacuum splints, spine board, crutches and emergency equipment bag located in the Martin Aquatics Center Athletic Training Room by Diving Well.

Emergency procedures

For an in-water emergency, lifeguards are first responders followed by on-site athletic trainer from USA Diving.

1. Use AED if warranted and perform emergency CPR and first aid
2. Instruct student athletic trainer, coach, or manager to call 911 - Provide the following information A) Who you are B) General information about the injury or situation C) Where you are - The Martin Aquatics Center on Biggio Drive behind Beard-Eaves Memorial coliseum (661 Heisman Dr.) D) Any additional information E) *BE THE LAST TO HANG UP* F) Meet the ambulance and direct it to the site
3. Meet ambulance at the Martin Aquatics Center rear entrance, off of Biggio Dr. (Doors by Diving Well)
5. Assist ATC and/or EMS with care as directed

Auburn/Opelika Area Medical Services

The Auburn/Opelika area is serviced by East Alabama Medical Center. In the event of any emergency, all athletes will be transported to the Emergency Room at the East Alabama Medical Center. Many Urgent Care Centers close to the main Auburn University campus can be utilized in non-emergency situations outside of meet hours, with the closest to campus listed below. Auburn University also has a student medical clinical that can be utilized during normal business hours. Note: In the case of any medical emergencies outside of meet hours, please utilize the East Alabama Medical Center for immediate medical attention.

PARKING

The entrance to Martin Aquatics Center is located on the east side of the building. Teams will be directed to the McWhorter, Kinesiology, and Hayfield (Auburn RV lot on Google Maps) lots for parking. The McWhorter lot is located approx. one block south of the Aquatics Center. The Kinesiology lot is located approx. one block west of the Aquatic Center. The Hayfield lot is located about .5 mile from the Aquatic Center off S. Donahue Drive across from the Auburn School of Nursing. Teams may drop off directly in front of the Aquatics Center.
