
## **Parking**

#### **Parking Information for Event Attendees**

- Saturday & Sunday: Parking is free of charge. The closest parking options to Belk Gym are:
  - 1. **Lot 7**
  - 2. Cone Deck 2
  - 3. West Deck

## **Playing system**

- Progressive Elimination
- Regardless of the Result Players will play between 4 and 10 matches, players must check their schedule as they progress.
   Participants can always check with Tournament Director to see if they have more matches.
- All events will finish next day after the start of the event (None of the players will finish same day)
- If a player defaults at any stage he or she will receive points equivalent to last place of that event
- All matches will be played using the best-of-five system.

## Reporting

All players need to report in the call area 10 minutes before the match. Players who don't report 10 minutes before are subject to default.

#### **Draws**

Draws will be made on May 26, 2025 using the latest available USATT Rating List for seeding – The Rating List will NOT include USATT Southwest Championships



#### **Accreditation**

All coaches will be required to have an accreditation to access the Field of Play. To be eligible for accreditation all coaches need to be fully Safe Sport Compliant and have a current criminal background check. All coaches will be required to request accreditation for 2025 Junior National Ranking Tournament 1. For accreditation fill the following: https://forms.office.com/r/NzmCZJgQdM

#### **Check-in Time**

## **Field of Play**

- During matches, up to 1 coach may sit at the bench this coach must be accredited.
- There is no practice allowed on competition tables during the event after the beginning of each session.
- All players and coaches must clear the field of play after their matches.

#### **SCORE SUBMISSION AND DRAWS**

- All Draws will be available on www.stadiumcompete.com All Match Times will be available there and submission will be done through Stadium TT
  - HOW TO REPORT SCORES ON STADIUM To get started, go to stadiumtt.com.
  - STEP 1 Identify Yourself
     Once you find the tournament on Stadium, click "Report scores as..."
     to verify your player profile by using your date of birth.
  - STEP 2 Report Your Scores
     To begin a match, click the pencil icon on the left. Enter game scores
     as you play.
  - STEP 3 Submit Your Match
     Once the entire match is completed, scroll down to find the Submit button. Show the scores on your device to your opponent. Ask them to sign their approval by entering the last two digits of their birth year. Match results only need to be submitted once.

## **Coaching Requirements for the 2025 Junior Ranking Tournament 1**

To be eligible to coach at the 2025 Junior Ranking Tournament 2, all coaches **must** meet the following requirements:

## **Mandatory Requirements:**

- SafeSport Certification: Coaches must be SafeSport compliant.
- Background Check: A valid and completed background check is required.

<u>∧</u> Important: Any individual who is **not SafeSport compliant** will **not** be permitted to coach at the Trials — **no exceptions**.

#### **Coaching Accreditation Fees:**

• Free Coaching Accreditation:

Coaches who meet all of the following criteria are eligible for free accreditation:

- SafeSport Compliant
- Background Check Completed
- Hold a valid USATT Coaching License
- o Completed ITTF or USATT Coach Education Program
- Coaching Pass Fee \$50:

Coaches who are **SafeSport compliant** and have passed a background check but **do not hold a valid USATT Coaching License** will be required to pay a \$50 Coaching **Pass Fee**.

### **Parent Access and Coaching:**

- **Parents** are granted **free entry** to the event as spectators.
- However, if a parent wishes to act as a coach, they must have a Coaching Pass
  - o If the parent does not hold a USATT Coaching License, they will be required to pay the \$50 Coaching Pass Fee (Parents are only allowed to coach their own children without being SafeSport Compliant)
