Position Summary

U.S. Biathlon is seeking a **Men's Senior National Team Head Coach**. This role is responsible for planning and executing year-round training, competition support, and athlete development for elite male biathletes competing on the World Cup and IBU Cup circuits.

The Men's Head Coach will work closely with the High Performance Director and broader staff to deliver a cohesive, athlete-centered high-performance program.

Key Responsibilities

Coaching & Performance

- Lead daily training and competition preparation for Men's Senior National Team (SNT) athletes
- Develop and oversee individualized training plans in collaboration with High Performance staff
- Maintain consistent communication with athletes
- Attend and lead coaching at training camps and international competitions
- Provide remote coaching support as needed

Program Leadership

- Plan Men's SNT training camps and seasonal programming
- Supervise assistant coach(es)

- Contribute to a unified U.S. Biathlon training system across all levels
- Mentor developing coaches within the US system

Collaboration

- Work closely with High Performance, Athlete Development, and Junior National Team (JNT) staff
- Support alignment across development pipeline (JNT → SNT)

Operations Support

- Assist with rifle/ammunition programs and equipment oversight
 - Support inventory and logistics for Men's Team equipment
 - Contribute to ongoing program development initiatives

- All Men's SNT training camps
 - World Cup and possibly some IBU Cup competitions
