## Rankings in Amateur Boxing

USA Boxing ranks its boxers from PeeWee to Elite divisions, and all boxers competing in designated events will attempt to earn points towards their USA Boxing national rankings. At the conclusion of each event, the top eight boxers in each weight category will receive points towards their rankings.

The primary purpose of the USA Boxing Ranking System is to identify and track the nation's top boxers at each age level. In turn, this will also develop a vehicle for athletes to monitor and track their progress amongst other athletes in their division and weight class. The USA Boxing Ranking System may also be used to determine seeding at USA Boxing's national events.

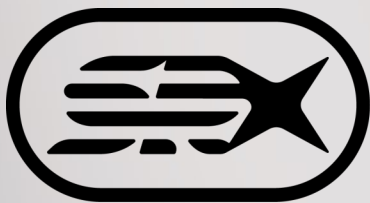

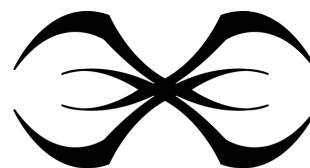

### SAFESPORT MAAPPS POLICY ON ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS

For the safety of our boxers, remember that all electronic communication must be *Open and Transparent*, meaning that:

- Communication between an Adult Participant and a Minor Athlete must include a parent/guardian, another adult family member of the Minor Athlete, or another Adult Participant.
- This includes all communication **even those initiated** by a Minor Athlete.
- Only electronic platforms that can be Open and Transparent should be used.
- All team communication or communications with multiple Minor Athletes from an Adult Participant must copy or include another Adult Participant, or all the Minor Athletes' parents/guardians.
- All communication must be professional in nature.
- Organizations must honor a parent/guardian's request to discontinue communication with their Minor Athlete unless there is an emergency.
- One-on-One exceptions are allowed.

USA Boxing has seen an uptick of forgeries in membership documents, specifically changing of dates in athletes' physicals.

Please know that all documents are verified and forgeries are considered a breach of the USA Code of Ethics and result in a membership suspension. There were 27 forgeries last year and 6 already in the first quarter of 2026.



## Disciplinary Process

USA Boxing has a review panel comprised of six (6) members of the USAB staff from different departments. Once a complaint has been received and validated, the process may be to issue Temporary Measures (which could include Admin Hold or Suspension) against the membership of the accused pending the investigation. The Respondent(s) is given the opportunity for their statement regarding the allegations. When possible, the **Panel meets up to twice per week and discusses at length, the issue and any disciplinary action(s)** against the person(s) who committed the violation(s). After a decision has been rendered, a letter of "Disciplinary Action" is emailed out with a requested response time for the acceptance or rejection of action. If a rejection is received, the matter is then presented to the Judicial Committee for review and/or hearing. Both the Admin Hold notice and the Disciplinary Letter are copied to the member's home LBC and other parties on a need to know basis. All cases are strictly confidential and never shared with a 3rd party. **Below is a recap of the reported cases the Panel has worked on in the 1st quarter of 2026.**

**GENERAL LIABILITY:** Protects your business for claims of bodily injury or property damage to others as well as providing coverage for allegations of personal and advertising injury.

**PROPERTY:** Protects your business's physical assets including buildings, stock, equipment, furnishings etc., from damage caused by perils such as fire, weather, theft and vandalism. Earthquake and flood coverage is typically not included but available separately.

**AUTOMOBILE:** As is required by law in most states, this provides liability and physical damage coverage for vehicles owned in the business name. Liability may also extend to employees driving personal vehicles for business purposes.

**WORKERS' COMPENSATION:** Provides coverage for medical expenses and lost wages of your employees who are injured or become ill in the course of their work. Requirements vary by state.

**EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES LIABILITY:** Protects your business from claims of discrimination, harassment, violation of the Family and Medical Leave Act, wrongful termination, discipline, etc.

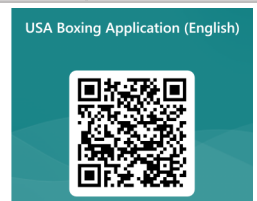
**UMBRELLA OR EXCESS LIABILITY:** Employer's liability to provide extra coverage in the event that a claim exceeds the limits included in the business's underlying policies.

**INLAND MARINE:** Covers your business's equipment and personal property when away from your business or being transported for an event.

**CYBER LIABILITY:** Coverage for your business's liability in case of a data breach involving sensitive customer information such as social security numbers, credit card numbers, account numbers, driver's license numbers and health records.

**DIRECTORS & OFFICERS LIABILITY:** Provides protection to directors and officers from personal liability for costly allegations of wrongful acts or omission in the performance of their duties, including mismanagement of funds or negligent decisions. Coverage may also include employment practices liability coverage for claims alleging harassment, discrimination or wrongful termination of employees.

### USA Boxing Elite High Performance Team Closes Strandja Event with Seven Medals

In February, the USA Boxing Elite High Performance Team concluded its contention with seven medals at the 77th International Strandja Boxing Tournament in Sofia, Bulgaria. Lavant Brownlee and Lorenzo Patricio each secured their first elite international medal during the competition. **Brownlee closed the tournament with a gold medal in the 70-kilogram division, while Patricio finished his tournament with a silver medal in the 55-kilogram division.**

Among 35 bouts contested by the United States, the USA Boxing Elite High Performance Team secured 22 wins throughout the week, resulting in seven medals. Of the 14 United States boxers competing throughout the week, 11 earned at least one win within their respective bracket, including four women and seven men.

**On top of Brownlee's gold medal and Patricio's silver medal, the USA Boxing Elite High Performance Team earned five bronze medals** from Yoseline Perez (Houston, TX), Alyssa Mendoza (Caldwell, ID), Simona Winkler (Seattle, WA, Naomi Graham (Colorado Springs, CO), and Joseph Awinongya (Joliet, IL).

The Stars and Stripes Team sent 14 boxers, seven men and seven women, to Sofia, Bulgaria, and had a quick turnaround as they are currently at the first World Boxing Cup of 2026, in Foz do Iguacu, Brazil.
