1) ALL ROUTINES

1 POINT PENALTY – All deducted from Routine score

- a) Exceeding time limit of 20/30 seconds for deck walk-on
- b) Exceeding time limit of ten (10) seconds for deck movements
- c) Deviation from the specified routine time limit allowed (+5 seconds)

2 POINT PENALTY – All deducted from Routine score

- a) Routine is interrupted by a competitor during the deck movements and a new start is allowed; deducted from Routine score
- b) Competitor(s) has made deliberate use of the bottom of the pool during a routine to propel themselves or assist another competitor; deducted from *Routine score* per violation

2) NOVICE ROUTINE

0.5 POINT PENALTY – All deducted from Element score

- a) Technical Required Element not performed parallel to the sides of the pool where the panels of judges have been placed (Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Trio only) per violation
- b) Element not performed simultaneously per violation
- c) Technical Required Element performed as mirror action per violation
- d) More than one free hybrid performed
- e) Acrobatic movement performed per violation

2 POINT PENALTY – All deducted from Element score

- a) Technical Required Element performed incorrectly
- b) Technical Required Elements not performed in order as stated in Appendix L
- c) The number of elements exceeds the predetermined maximum allowance; deducted from *Elements score* per violation

3) INTERMEDIATE ROUTINE

0.5 POINT PENALTY – All deducted from Element score

- a) Technical Required Element not performed parallel to the sides of the pool where the panels of judges have been placed (Solo, Duet, Mixed Duet, Trio) per violation
- b) Technical Required Element performed as mirror action per violation
- c) Additional elements not performed per violation

2 POINT PENALTY – All deducted from Element score

- a) Technical Required Element performed out of order
- b) The number of elements exceeds the predetermined maximum allowance per violation

ZERO – All deducted from Element score

- a) One or more swimmers omit or perform incorrect action in a Technical Required Element

4) MASTERS ROUTINE

0.5 POINT PENALTY

- a) Additional elements not performed per violation

2 POINT PENALTY – All deducted from Element score

- a) Technical Required Element performed incorrectly
- b) Technical Required Elements not performed in order as declared on Coach Card or as stated in Appendix L

5) FREE COMBINATION – MASTERS

1 POINT PENALTY

- a) New part does not start in very close proximity to the previous part; deducted from *Routine score*

2 POINT PENALTY – All deducted from Routine score

- a) Does not have two parts fewer than three athletes and two parts with all athletes
- b) Theme not portrayed; not necessary on Coach Card

6) DISQUALIFICATION

1) ALL ROUTINES
