## **VENUE**

Purchase College (Physical Education Building)

735 Anderson Hill Road

Purchase, NY 10577

Upon entering the campus there will be signs directing you to the pool. (After entering the campus you will take your first right. Take this road approximately one mile and the first building on your right will be the Physical Education Building. You will feel like you are passing the building and then you will see the road that you turn right on to take you behind the building to Parking lot E6. There is an entrance in the back of the building. Enter the building and you will go up one floor to Level 1. There will be signs there that will direct you to the pool.)

## **FACILITY AND EQUIPMENT**

Pool Equipment – Two 1-meter boards (maxi-flex B), and Two 3-meter boards (maxi-flex B)

Dryland Equipment – Dryland Board & Port-a-Pit on-deck

One Trampoline on-deck

### **REGISTRATION**

All participants must be “Current” members of USA Diving. All athlete and coach entries must be made online at [www.divemeets.com](http://www.divemeets.com) prior to April 8<sup>th</sup>. No athlete or coach will be permitted access to the pool deck without having completed their DiveMeets registration. Athletes may still register after the deadline up until 3 hours prior to their event with an added late fee of \$100. If a coach misses the online registration deadline, a \$20 late fee will be assessed prior to deck authorization.

The event entry fees for this event are \$50 plus a \$20 insurance fee per athlete per event (total \$70 per event).

### **DIVE CHANGES**

All dive changes, including payment, MUST be done online through DiveMeets. Athletes may log into their DiveMeets account to review and update their dive sheets within the timeline outlined below:

1. Changes may be made online at no cost before 6pm the night prior to the first day’s events, and before 12pm the day prior to all competition days thereafter.
2. After the designated times in point 1, athletes may make changes to their dive sheets online at a cost of \$15 per event up until 3 hours prior to their event start time.
3. Dive changes will no longer be accepted three hours prior to the corresponding event.

### **PARTICIPANT COMPORMENT**

USA Diving promotes good sportsmanship from athletes, coaches and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, racist or sexist comments, or other intimidating actions directed at judges, meet personnel, athletes, coaches, spectators, or team representatives are grounds for removal from the site of competition. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing or bullying, and acts of cyberbullying by members towards any member is strictly prohibited. Retaliation against any person who reports, is thought to have reported, files a complaint or otherwise participates in an investigation or

inquiry is also strictly prohibited. False charges shall also be regarded as a serious offense and will result in disciplinary action or other appropriate sanctions. Persons whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. USA Diving may also make referrals to law enforcement officials.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing rooms is not appropriate and is prohibited.

**TECHNICAL MEETING**

8:30 am on both days of competition.

**Timeline:**

A timeline will be released as quickly as possible once the late fee has taken effect. Event competitions may run slightly faster (15+ minutes) or may run longer than timeline indicates depending on the number of competitors.

**Additional Details**

Prior to each event, there will be a warm-up limited to participants of that event. Awards will be presented prior to the beginning of the following event. 1m & 3m awards will be presented together by age group.

**JUDGING**

Each region will be attended by one AQUA-Certified USA Diving Judge to serve as a Head Referee of the event.

**CHECK-IN TABLE**

On deck as soon as you enter the pool.

**RESTROOMS**

Available right next to the pool.

### **FIRST AID/MEDICAL SERVICES**

A First Aid room with supplies is available in the pool area, right behind the diving boards. Lifeguards will be working whenever the pool is open for warm-up and competition.

### **COACH HOSPITALITY**

Food and Drinks are available whenever the pool is open for warm-up and competition.

### **EVENT MERCHANDISE**

Custom, event-branded apparel will be available on-site, provided by USA Diving's merchandise partner, Fine Designs. Get your 2024 USA Diving Regional Championships gear at their stand throughout the event!

### **PARKING**

As noted above, parking is behind the Physical Education Building in Lot E6 (East 6). Additional parking lots for overflow are available across the street in front of the Physical Education Building.

### **TICKETING**

Information on ticketing will be posted at the entrance of the pool.

### **FOOD/CONCESSIONS**

Food and Drinks are available at the concession area whenever the pool is open for warm-up and competition. **Only on days of the competition.**

### **WIFI**

Signs in the pool will be provided during warm-ups and competition that will provide details on how to connect to WIFI.

## **STREAMING**

If streaming is available, details will be provided at the pool.

## **DECK MAP**

Upon entering the pool, everything is visible and signs will provide directions to the food & concession area as well as to the guest viewing area (in the balcony).
