I also backed Ronda Rousey's Olympic journey, helping raise substantial funds for her trip to Beijing. Additionally, my service on the US Judo Association Board from 2009 to 2013, alongside my support of Gary Goltz as President, contributed to stabilizing and growing the organization.

If elected to the Board of USA Judo, I am confident that, alongside Gary Goltz, we can evaluate, retool, and recapture the greatness of American Judo. Our combined efforts will work towards ensuring a strong and celebrated performance by US Judoka at the 2028 Los Angeles Olympics.
