

IFJI Strategic Plan 2025

Mission:

The mission of Island Flow Judo Incorporated in the year 2026 will be to establish a foundation for the promotion of amateur judo in the State of Hawaii through competition, athlete and coach development and athlete and coach financial support.

Initiatives:

- Competition – A regular tournament schedule will be established to provide a safe and competitive environment for judoka throughout the state. Tournaments will be organized to prepare athletes and coaches for USA Judo and IJF style tournaments.
 - Host four state tournaments throughout the year. The first three tournaments will establish ranks for athletes that will determine seeding at the fourth tournament (state championships).
 - Host 1 USA Judo pointed tournament.
- Athlete and Coach Development – Provide additional resources for both athletes and coaches to further their knowledge and improve their skills.
 - Hold bi-weekly joint practices between participating judo clubs to promote diverse training and knowledge exchange.
 - Organize and host clinics with the goal of improving athletic knowledge, athletic performance or coaching methodologies.
 - Confirm at least 2 IJF Level 1 Instructors as members.
- Athlete and Coach Financial Support – Create a system for top level athletes to more easily access out of state competition.
 - Provide a qualification standard that all members can strive to meet that would qualify them to be sponsored in full or in part by the Corporation for endeavors related to competitive amateur judo.
- Increase Membership – Promote the sport of judo and the corporation to support the growth of individual membership of each organizational member by 5% over the calendar year of 2026.
