The 2025 Para Swimming World Series - USA is a pathway event for athletes on the road to the 2025 World Championships. The competition will showcase top Paralympic athletes alongside emerging talent.

U.S. Paralympics Swimming is currently looking for 43 volunteers per session to support the competition. No prior experience is necessary to serve in any of the following positions:

- 1. **Timer** must be 18 years or older with no relationship to any competing athlete
- 2. Basket Carrier minimum age 12
- 3. Credential Check minimum age 14
- **4.** Runner minimum age 14
- **5. USADA Chaperone** must be 18 years or older with no relationship to any competing athlete
