# Athletes' eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

All participants must be U21; that is, they must have been born between January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005, and December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

To participate in the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games, each athlete must comply with the regulations established by Panam Sports as well as with the regulations of the International Judo Federation / Pan American Judo Confederation. The National Federation and the athlete must be currently affiliated to the Pan American Judo Confederation and the International Judo Federation by 2025.









The athlete must be registered by his or her NOC in the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games' registration system.

### **Qualification system**

- 1. 07 first places of the Pan American ranking per each weight category.
- 2. 01 quota per weight category will be directly allocated to the host country. The athlete must have participated in at least one event of the qualification circuit.
- 3. Maximum of one representative per country in each weight category.
- 4. The score will be of the athlete and will not leave the quota to his/her country (in case of not competing).
- 5. The four (04) best scores obtained between qualification events will be considered. The athlete must have a minimum of 80 points to be considered eligible for qualification.
- 6. If two or more athletes have the same score in the ranking, the ranking will be decided by:
  - a. The athlete who, in his/her 4 best scores in qualification events, has the highest sum of points obtained in Junior Pan American Championships;
  - b. If a tie persists, the athlete who in his/her 4 best scores in qualification events, has the highest sum of points obtained in Junior Pan American Cups;
  - c. If a tie persists, the highest score of an event will be considered; then, if required, the second highest score will be considered and so on.
  - d. If the athletes remain tied, the Pan American Judo Confederation Executive Committee will make the decision.
- 7. In case that a quota cannot be reallocated in a weight category:
  - a. The quota will be reallocated to the athlete with the highest score (female or male) across all the gender's weight categories,
  - b. The athlete must have a minimum of 80 points to be eligible,
  - c. The maximum quota per NOC in each weight category must be respected,
  - d. The tie-breaker system described in point 6 shall apply.

<sup>1</sup>Athletes must win at least one combat to obtain the points of the 1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 3<sup>rd</sup> place, 5<sup>th</sup> place, 7<sup>th</sup> place, 17<sup>th</sup> place.

<sup>2</sup>"Participation" points will be awarded in weight categories in which 2 or more athletes are drawn. An athlete who does not win any combat after having gone through the corresponding weigh-ins will get participation points.

<sup>3</sup> If an athlete is the only one entered in a weight category of a qualifying circuit event, he/she must successfully pass the corresponding weigh-ins to obtain the points indicated in the above chart.

## **Confirmation of quotas**

The Pan American Judo Confederation will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that each NOC has qualified no later than April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and the Judo Pan American Confederation the places they will use no later than April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

# Reallocation of unused quotas

If necessary, the Pan American Judo Confederation will reallocate unused quotas to the next best positioned NOC that has not yet qualified, no later than April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

NOCs that received reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025.





#### **Qualification for Lima 2027 Pan American Games**

In Judo, all gold medalists of individual events will obtain direct qualification to the Lima 2027 Pan American Games. A total of 7 places for each gender (14 in total) will be allocated in these competitions.

The places obtained are for the athletes, not for the country. If the athlete who earned the quota cannot participate in the Lima 2027 Pan American Games, the quota will be lost and may not be transferred to the country or to any other athlete placed in another position in the II Junior Pan American Games Asuncion 2025.
