Position Summary:

USA Team Handball seeks a visionary, qualified leader to serve as Head Coach of the U.S. Men's or Women's Senior National Team. This position plays a central role in shaping the competitive future of the United States on the global handball stage, with a focus on preparing the team for the LA 2028 Olympic Games and related international competitions.

The Head Coach will lead all aspects of the Senior National Team program while contributing to the development and integration of the full high-performance pipeline. This includes close collaboration with junior, youth, and cadet programs, as well as both U.S.-based and Europe-based athlete pools.

Key Responsibilities:

- Lead all technical, tactical, and performance aspects of the Senior National Team
- Design and implement long- and short-term training and competition plans
- Oversee athlete evaluation, selection, and development for senior competition
- Collaborate with junior, youth, and cadet program staff to ensure alignment of playing philosophy, athlete tracking, and performance standards
- Support the identification and development of U.S.-based and Europe-based pipeline athletes
- Ensure, with support of USATH staff, compliance with USOPC, SafeSport, anti-doping, and other applicable regulatory requirements
- Assist in assembling a coaching and support staff capable of managing the broad developmental and operational needs of the program
- Contribute to the strategic vision for U.S. handball, including near- and long-term performance frameworks and coach/athlete development systems
- Work with USATH leadership to align program activities with strategic high-performance objectives



- Represent USATH in international competitions, events, and technical meetings as needed
- Uphold and promote a culture of professionalism, integrity, and athlete-centered coaching

Preferred Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience coaching at a high-performance level (national team, international club, or equivalent)
- Strong knowledge of modern handball systems, training methodologies, and long-term athlete development
- Proven ability to lead integrated, multi-level performance environments
- Familiarity with Olympic sport structures and international federation competition calendars
- Experience working across multiple athlete pools or geographically distributed teams preferred
- Ability to operate effectively in decentralized, travel-intensive environments
- Demonstrated leadership, communication, and team-building skills across diverse stakeholder groups
- Familiarity with compliance obligations within Olympic and national governing body environments
- Must be legally eligible to travel to and work within the United States
- English proficiency required; additional languages a plus

Contract Terms:

This is a contract-based position. Compensation, where applicable, is defined in individual agreements. Reimbursement for approved travel and related expenses is provided. USA Team Handball is headquartered in Colorado; applicants must be eligible to operate as independent contractors under applicable U.S. and Colorado law and must be legally permitted to enter and work in the United States.
